

## N.S.S.

National Service Scheme is a Central Government Programme- that comes to state government to universities.

It was first introduced in Gujarat University in 1969. The Programme was at that same time started in St. Xavier's College.

The main aim of the N.S.S. Programme is to help in the upliftment of the weaker section of the society.

As per Gujarat University guidelines we adopt one area and two blind schools. From the very beginning we have adopted the Gulabi Tekra Slums with our students helping in various aspects/activities like Adult Education, Population Control, Cleanliness, Anti Tobacco and Drug Awareness Campaign etc.

Everyday a group of students visits two blind schools: One in Navrangpura and other in Memnagar. The students help the blind students in reading, writing and preparing cassettes etc.

Some N.S.S. Students voluntarily help in our College Campus cleaning, tree plantation and library work etc.

Every year we organize a blood donation camp with the help of the Red Cross Society.
