

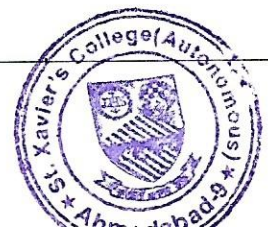



1.0		<u>Objective:</u>
	1.1	To support the students in SXCA who do not have adequate financial resources to see them through their studies comfortably. The College has reserved funds to support such students.

	2.1	Scholarships & freeships provided under the guidelines of donors for reserved category of students of SXCA.
	2.2	Needy Student Fund/Poor Boys Fund covers all the students of SXCA, who are eligible to get scholarship & freeships as per the guidelines set by the SXCA.
3.0		<u>Applicability:</u>
	3.1.	Scholarships and prizes (including trophies, certificates, cash prizes) are established to recognize meritorious students in academics, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
	3.2.	<p>In SXCA several prizes are established for deserving students under various categories and for outstanding students. 	3.3.	In keeping with the Jesuit tradition to take education to the underprivileged, SXCA has set up a Fund named the Needy Students Fund/Poor Boys Fund . The fund is supported by the donations from well-wishers and seeks to assist economically/needy/challenged students who choose to apply for aid and whose cases are considered after scrutiny of their application and verification of the records by a committee set up by the Principal/Management.
	3.4	The concessions are generally granted to students irrespective of their academic performance. In such cases recommendation from the competent authority is taken into account before granting the concessions.
