The 8th meeting of the Finance committee was held on December 17, 2019 from 11.45 am onwards in the Board Room of the College. Chairman conducted the meeting.

The minutes of the last Finance committee meeting (No. 7) were passed unanimously by the committee.

The Utilization Certificate along with the Income and Expenditure Statement of the Autonomy Grant for the Financial Year 2018-2019 was presented for scrutiny, which was duly approved. The Grants spent so far for the Financial Year 2019-2020, were also reviewed. It was suggested to take into account proper fund allocation under various heads so that there is no issue of under utilization of grant.

The Finance Committee approved the expenditure estimates for the Financial Year 2020-2021 subject to availability of grant from UGC. Committee further resolved to incur the expenditure on receiving letter of approval from UGC.
