## St Xavier's College (Autonomous), Ahmedabad-9 Minutes of the 10<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Examination Committee held on August 21, 2020

Meeting No. 10 of the Examination committee was held on August 21, 2020 from 3.30pm onwards on Google meet. The CoE welcomed the members to the meeting.

### Examination under COVID-19

The CoE informed that according to the directives of Gujarat University, the UG Sem II and IV as well as PG Sem IV will be granted merit-based progression (MBP). The details for the MBP calculations are awaited.

The examination for UG Sem VI and PG Sem IV have been finalized during the HOD meeting. The methodology of the examination will be as elaborated below:

- For UG Sem VI the exam format will be assignment and Viva voce. The Assignment will of 36 marks and the Viva voce 34 marks. There should be 4 ques from 4 units. Due to COVID-19; students need to answer any three full questions of the four in the question paper in their own handwriting; scan all pages of answers of assignment and upload to either Moodle course page or send it to departmental email.
- The students will be given 15 days for submission and it can be extended for some cases with permission in extra ordinary conditions.
- Viva voce will be conducted by the respective faculties in accordance to the time-table prepared. The time-table should be communicated to the students in advance.
- For departments with student strength more than 50 in UG Sem VI, they can opt for mcq based-ESE examination on Moodle. The mcqs have to be randomized and the time given should be equal to the marks of the question. The questions should be sequential. The specific instructions will be communicated to the departments opting for this method
- For PG Sem IV; all departments have to opt for Assignment+ viva format. For PG external examiners can be invited for viva voce of dissertation and industrial trainings
- All grievances related to examinations can be sent to CoE office or Vice-principal's office

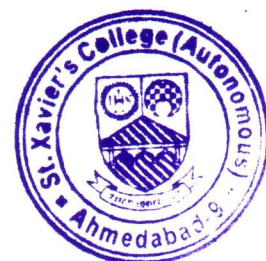
