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Minutes of Micro IQAC Meeting 30 held on 16th Sept, 2020

Welcome: Dr. C. J. Clement welcomed the members and informed them about the need for moderation in the ESE MCQ exam conducted in September, 2020

Agenda 1: To discuss the need for moderation and suggest an appropriate moderation method for the ESE MCQ exam conducted in September 2020

Dr. C. J. Clement shared his observations regarding the MCQ exam that the curve of the results was skewed for some departments hence, he suggested to choose around 10 questions from each MCQ quiz and regrade them depending on their difficulty level. This may lead to normalization of the curve. For this, the statistical data obtained from moodle was shared with the members for further suggestions.

Dr. Nandita Christy suggested the existence of a formula used in BITS, Pilani for normalization of the results of various boards during B.Tech admissions. Dr. Nandita recommended to take the help of Prof Bhaduaria in this regard.

Dr. Francis Christy suggested that the team should check the curve for all exams conducted and work on only those with skewed result curves. He suggested that the result analysis curves for all the previous semesters must be analysed and compared; before deciding on a common formula to moderate the ESE MCQ exam results. Dr. Francis also suggested that departments should analyse individual results of students, taking into consideration the progress every year and then decide upon a common moderation technique.

Dr. Clement opined that the previous semesters need not be considered for individual students but the overall class results can be analysed to arrive at a common moderation method.

Dr. Francis and Dr. Nandita were of the opinion that a common formula may affect the grades of advanced level learners also.

Resolution/Decision taken: The results of all sets of MCQs per paper will be merged and the result analysis curve will be studied. Further decisions will be made based on the analysis curves and after seeking further inputs from Prof. Bhaduaria
