Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) 2020-21


INTRODUCTION

SURVEY PROCESS



1203 responses were obtained, of which 44.8 % were from science, 29.5% were from arts, 16.5 % were from computer sciences and 9.1% were from commerce.


Gender:

40% respondents were male and 60% female




How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?


How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?


How well were the teachers able to communicate?


Fairness and transparency of the evaluation process.


Efforts are made by the college/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.


How effective is the LMS-Moodle in the teaching-learning and evaluation process?


Are you satisfied with the method and speed by which information is communicated to you by the college?


College provides ample opportunities to participate in cultural activities



SURVEY ANALYSIS

From the survey conducted, it is concluded that:

1. More than 76.7% of the students agree that the teaching process is very good and that the teachers were well prepared for the class with effective communication skills
2. 88.9 % students agreed that more than 70 % syllabus was covered in class
3. 93% students were satisfied with the classroom teaching in the College
4. 90.5 % students found the LMS-Moodle effective for online teaching
5. The students were satisfied with the fairness in evaluation and the methodology adopted during the COVID-19 pandemic
6. 79% of the students were satisfied with the extra-curricular activities provided in the online mode during 2020-21
7. The students were also satisfied with the speed of communication from the college regarding administrative activities
8. The students had a divided opinion on the efforts are made by the college/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work. 35.7 % felt that sufficient efforts are being made but 39.5% felt that only moderate efforts are made

The survey identified the following plans for the IQAC:

1. Introducing more skill-based components in the curriculum
2. Introducing events, activities and content leading to making students more employable
