
SURVEY PROCESS



The responses were rated one a five-point scale, with 5 being excellent and 1 being average


SURVEY SAMPLE



681 responses were obtained, of which 30.5 % were from science, 52.4% were from arts, 1.5 % were from computer sciences and 15.6 % were from commerce.




From the 678 responses, 10.3 % were Sem I students of 23-24, 33.2% were Sem I (UG) students of 22-23, 21.4 % students were of Sem III (UG), 21.5 % were students of Sem IV(UG), 7.7 % were from Sem I (PG) and 5.9% were from Sem III(PG).




35.2% respondents were male and 64.6% female

SURVEY ANALYSIS

From the survey conducted, it is concluded that:

- 89.4 % of the students rated the quality of teaching as good to excellent and 43.8 % students felt that there was good to excellent usage of ICT tools by teachers
- 87.8% students responded that the syllabus was relevant and 77.9 % students felt that there was good amount of content in the syllabus offering skill-development, entrepreneurship, and employability.
- In the comments section, students have requested to systematize the internal evaluation pattern but 86.5% of the survey respondents are satisfied with the external evaluation.
- 70-85% students are satisfied with the sports infrastructure, classroom/seminar halls, library facilities, grievance redressal mechanism, placement cell, extra-curricular activities, research activities and extension activities. Almost 96% students expressed satisfaction in the landscaping and greenness of the campus.
- There were some concerns regarding the College Hostel

The survey identified the following plans for the next academic year:

- 1. An overhaul of the internal evaluation system. This will also be necessitated due to the implementation of NEP-2020 in the next academic year
- 2. Take steps to improve the food in the canteen
- 3. Improve placements for final year students
