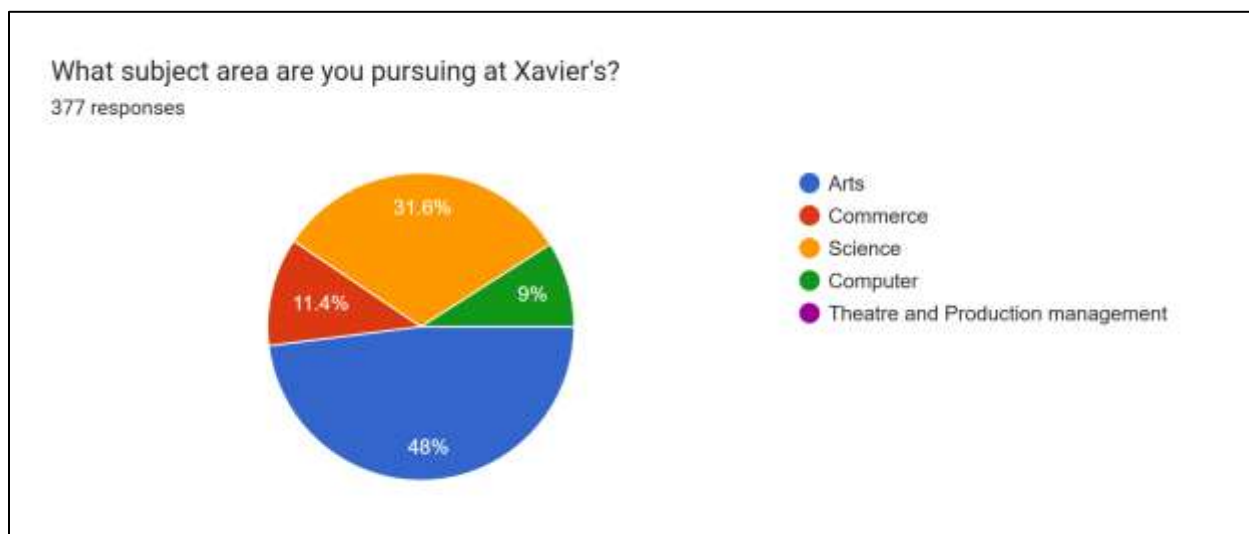
SURVEY PROCESS

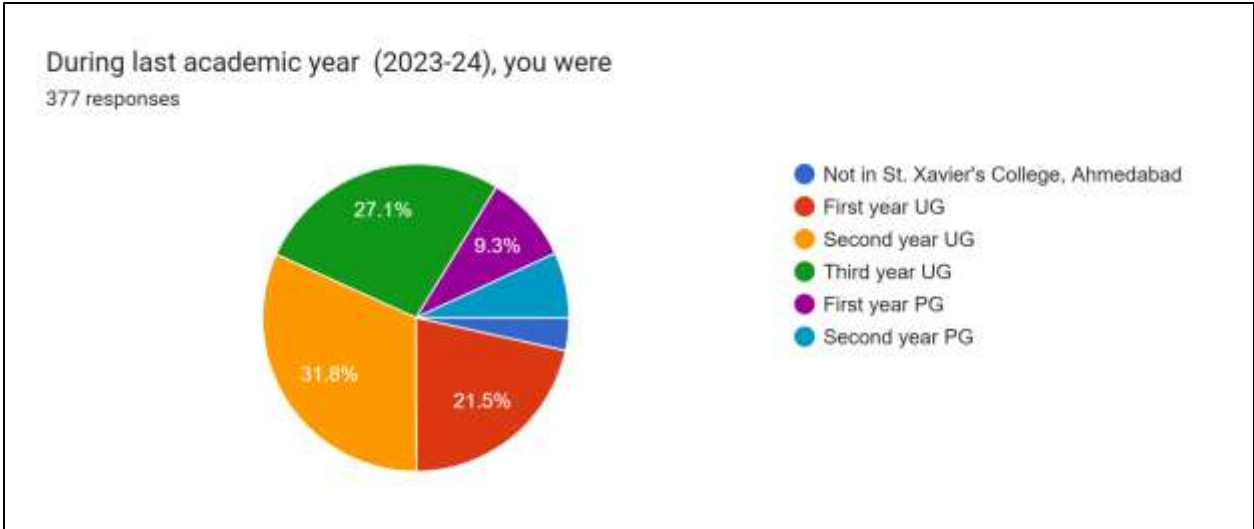

The responses were rated on a five-point scale, with 5 being excellent and 1 being average

SURVEY SAMPLE



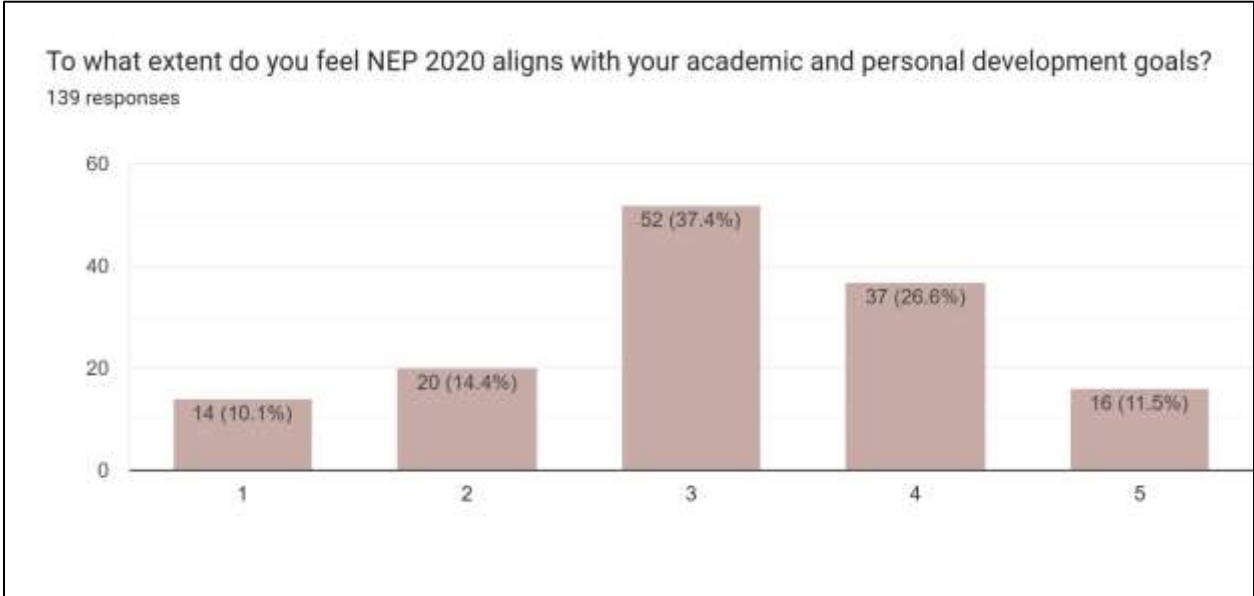
337 responses were obtained, of which 31.6 % were from science, 48% were from arts, 9 % were from computer sciences and 9% were from commerce



From the 337 responses, 21.5 % were Sem I (UG) students, 9.3 % were Sem I (PG) students, 31.8 % students were of Sem III (UG), 27.1 % were students of Sem IV(UG), and 3.4% were from Sem III(PG).

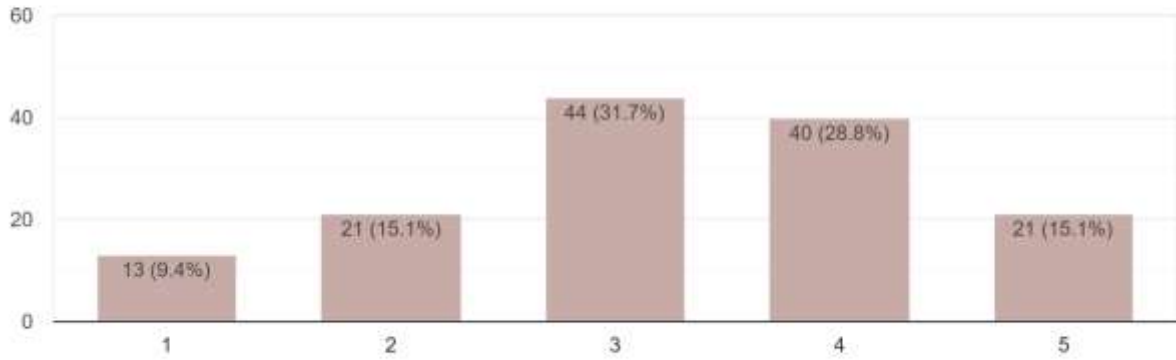

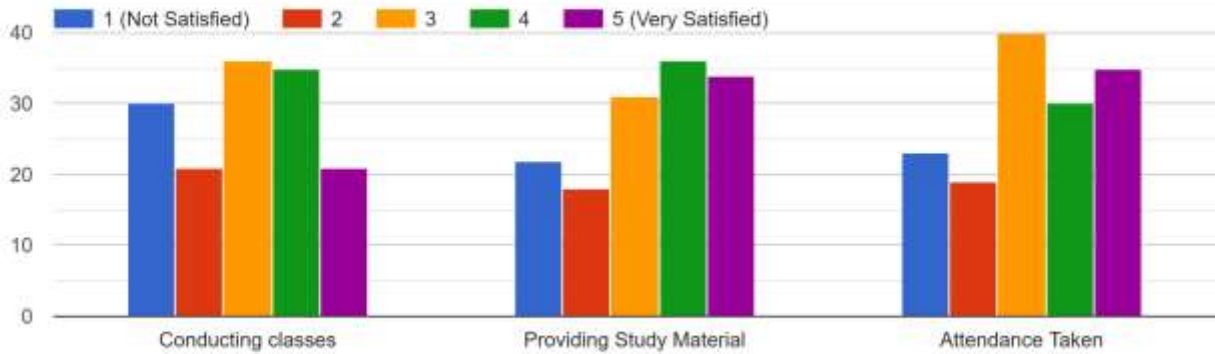


How much has the introduction of technology in education (such as online learning platforms, digital tools) affected your learning experience?

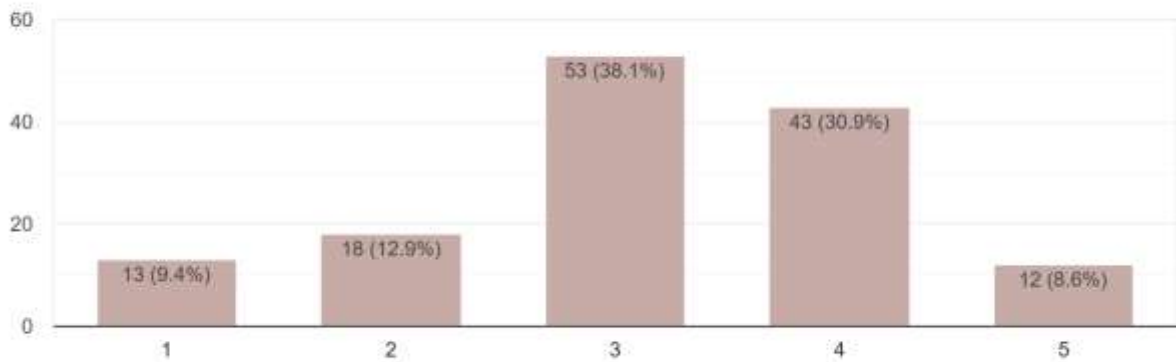


How satisfied are you with the online courses based on



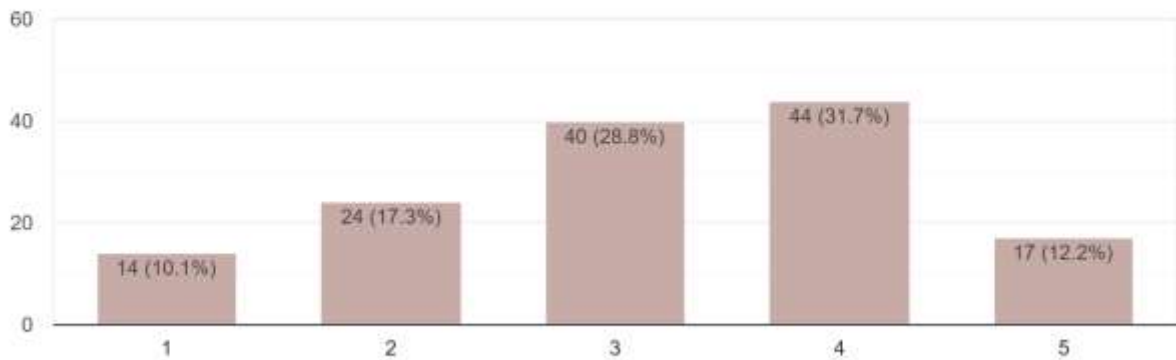
Do you think the assessment methods under NEP 2020 are reasonable and effective?

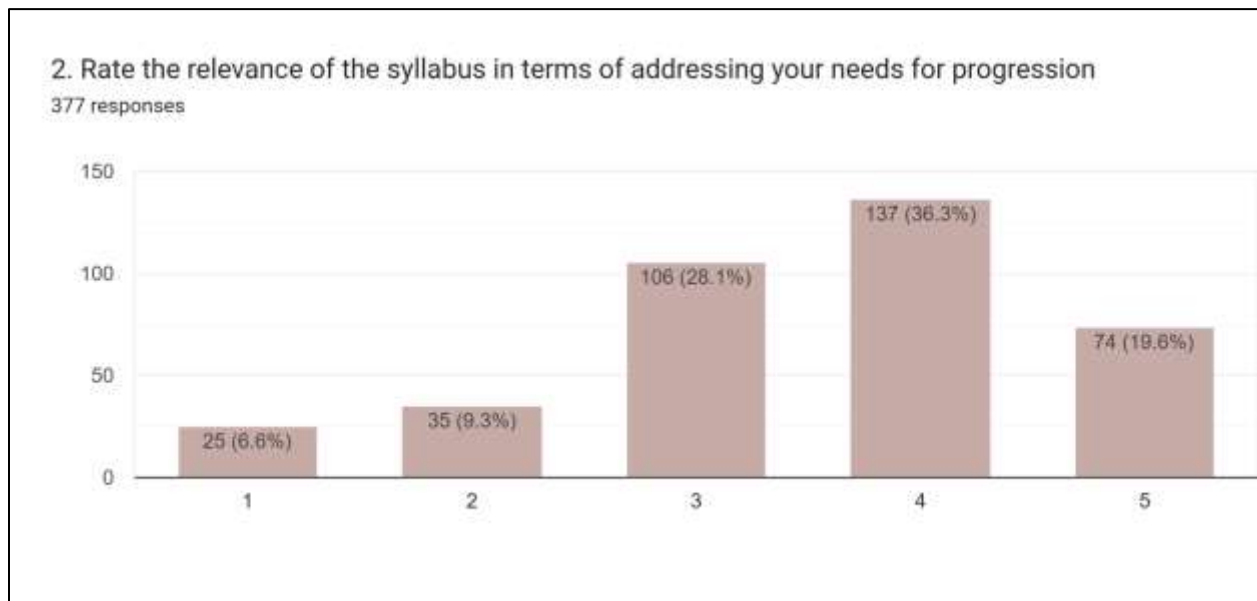
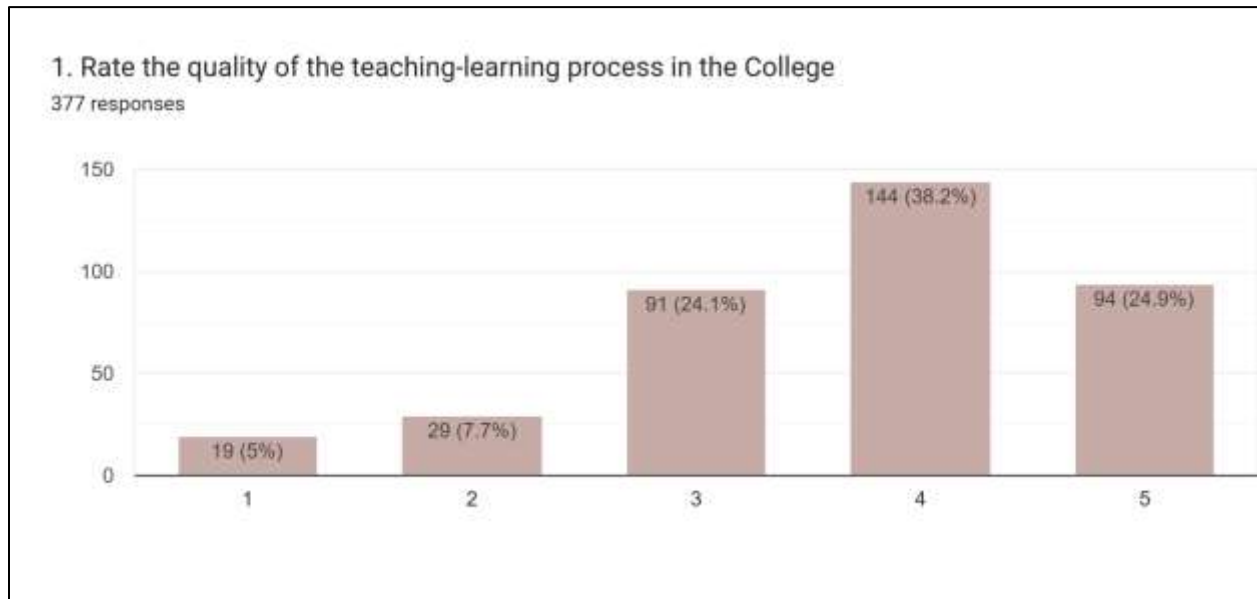


Do you feel that NEP 2020 provides adequate opportunities for skill development alongside academic learning?

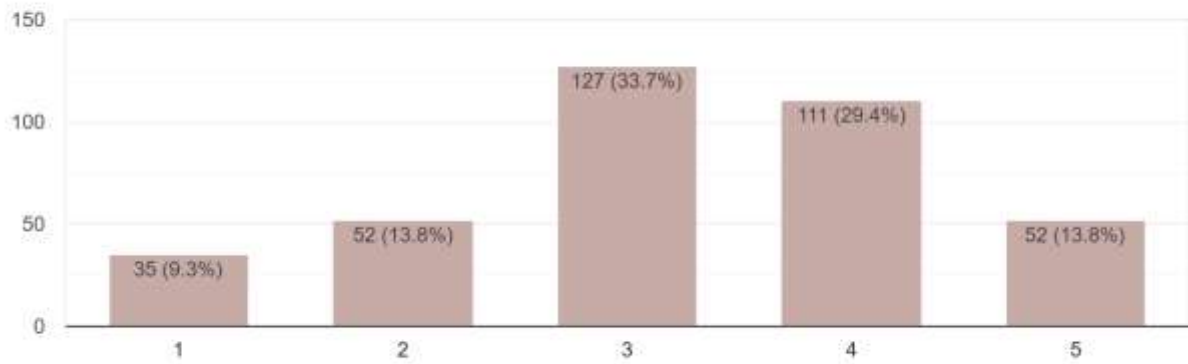

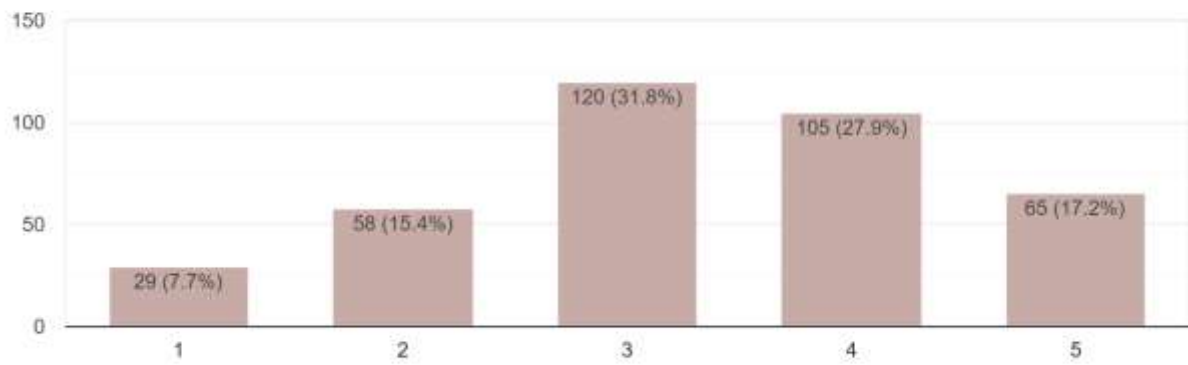
3. Use of ICT tools for teaching-learning

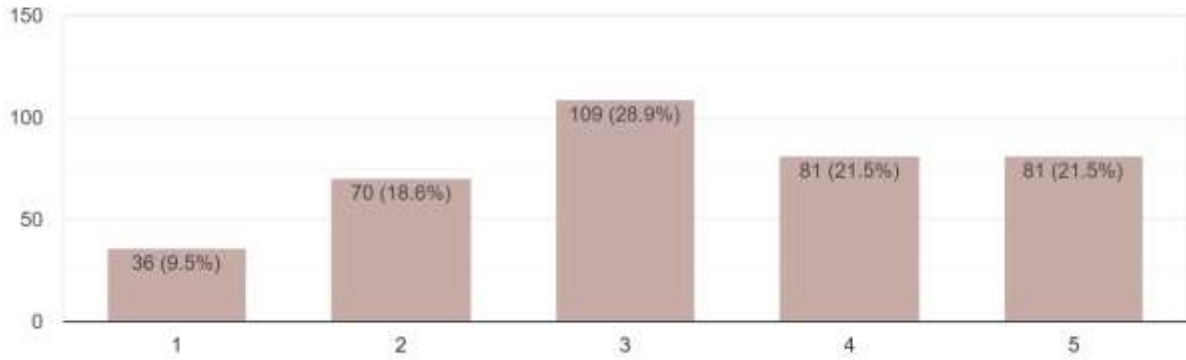
4. Rate the quality of courses in terms of offering skill-development, entrepreneurship and employability

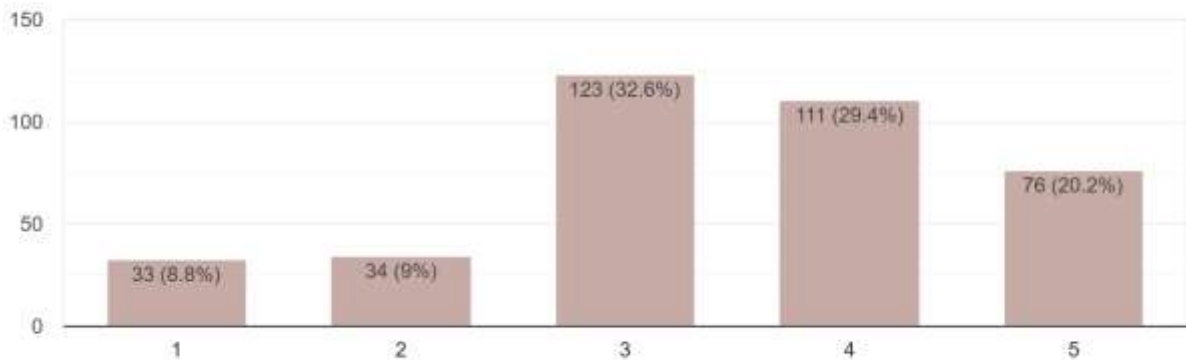
5. Rate the offerings of the College in terms of remedial classes, seminars, conferences, workshops, coaching for competitive exams

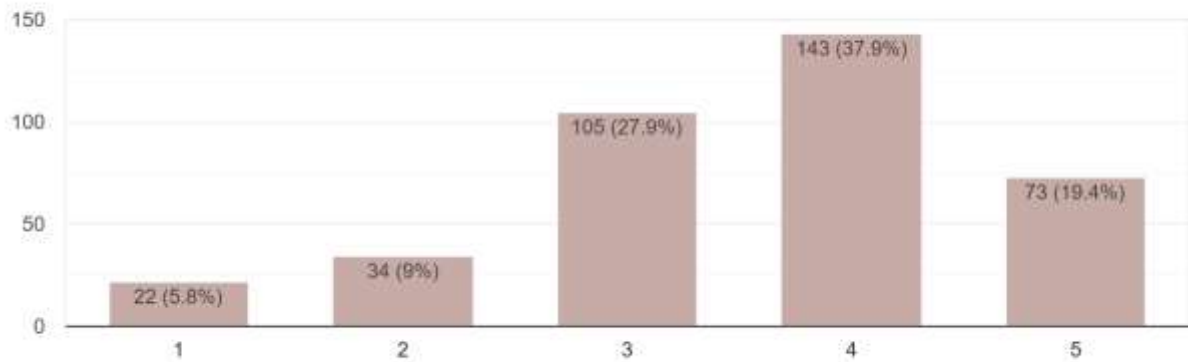
6. Rate the internal evaluation pattern

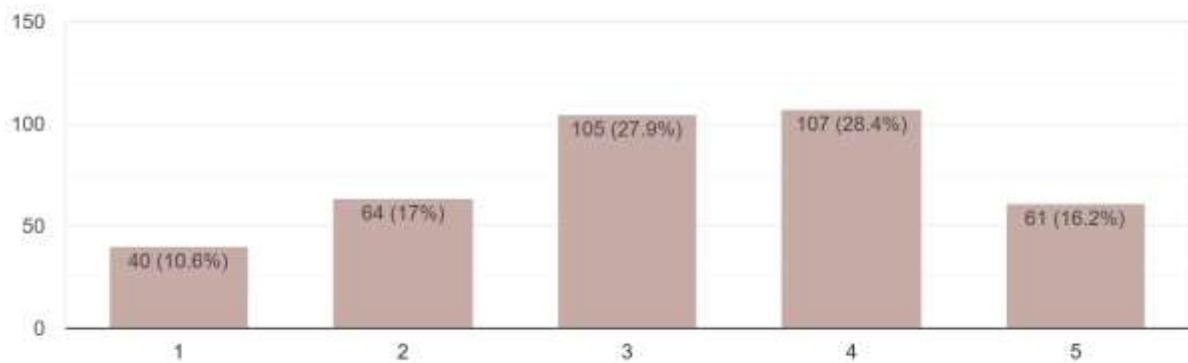

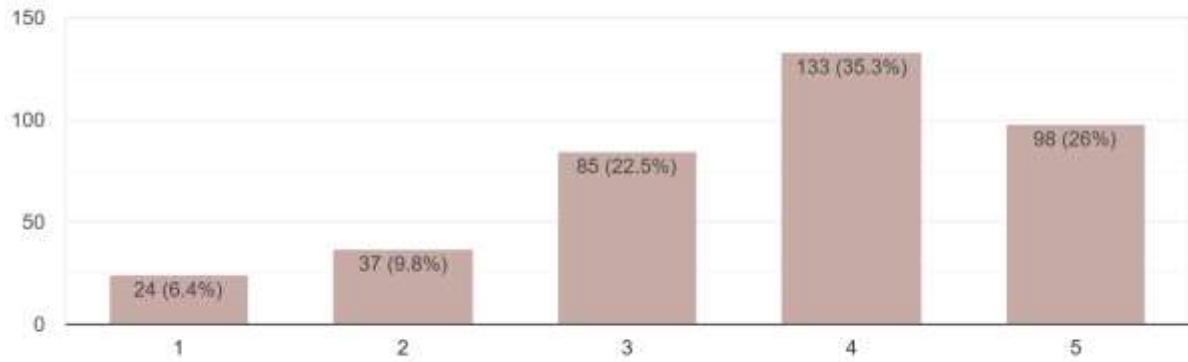
8. Rate the ambience of the Classrooms & Seminar rooms

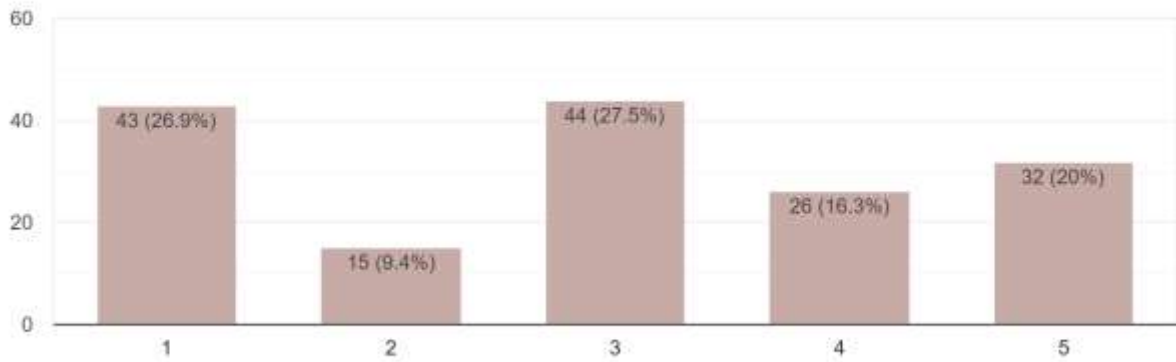
9. Rate the availability of books, journals and other reading materials from the library

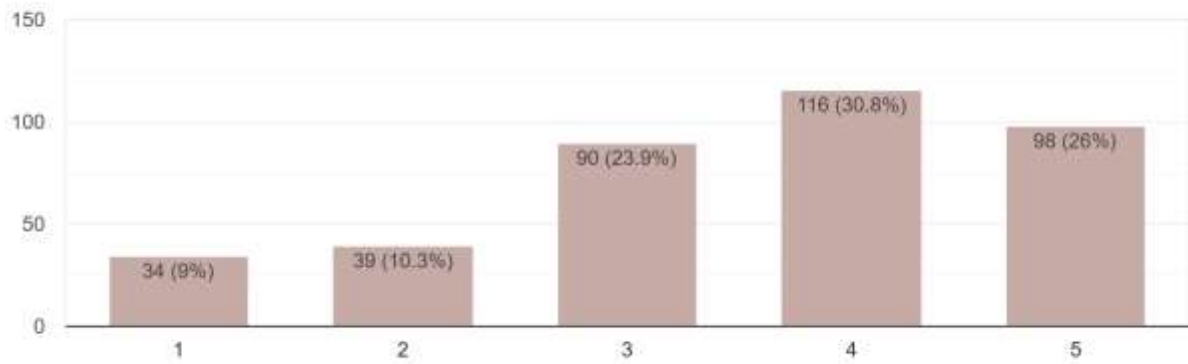
10. Rate the facilities provided in the College Hostel (only for those availing hostel facilities)

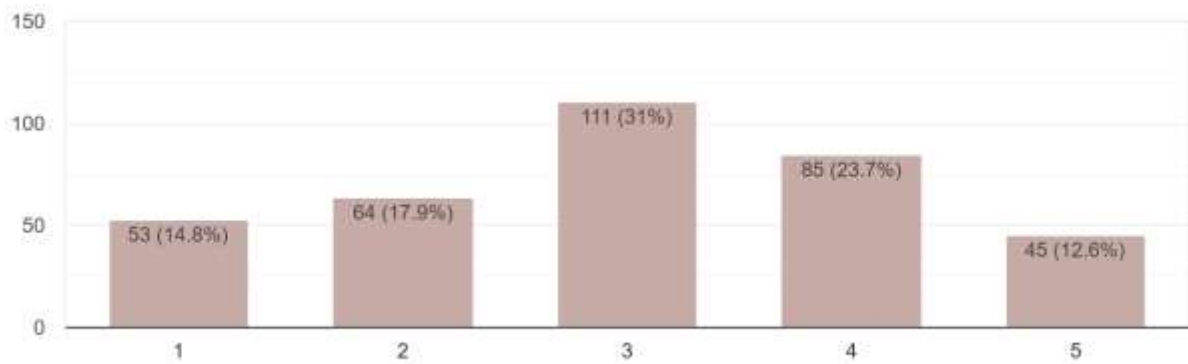
11. Rate the sports facilities available in the College

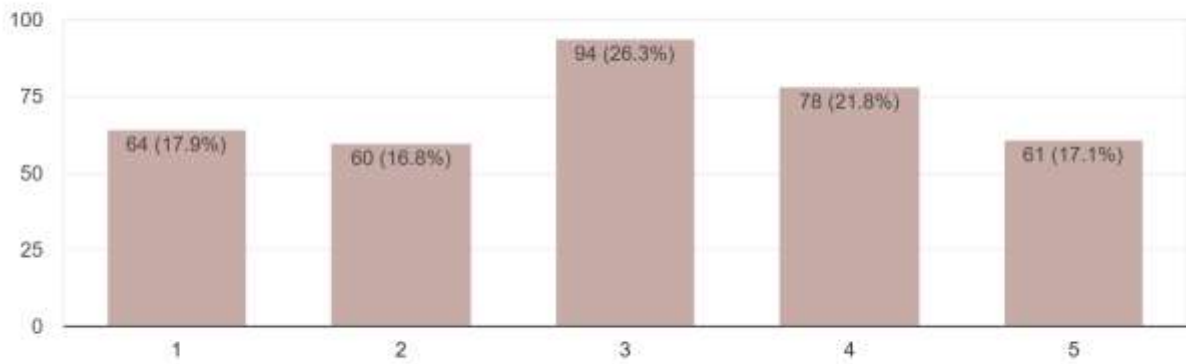
12. Rate the quality of food in the College Canteen

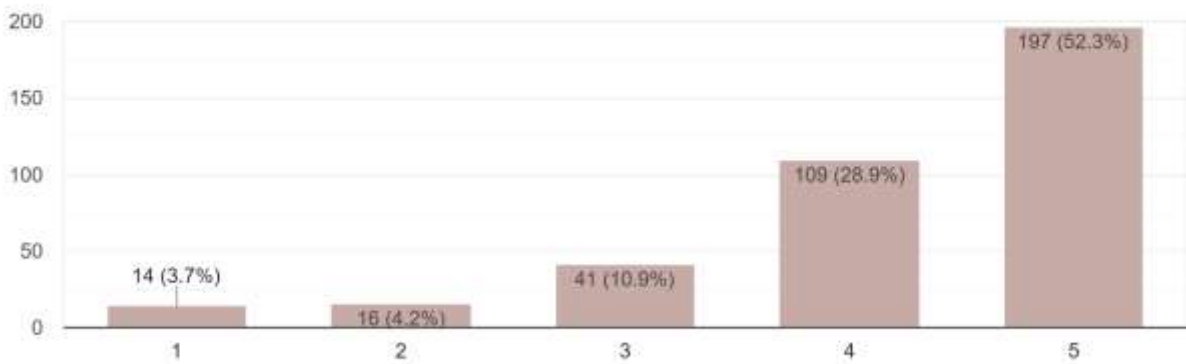
13. Rate the ambience in the College canteen

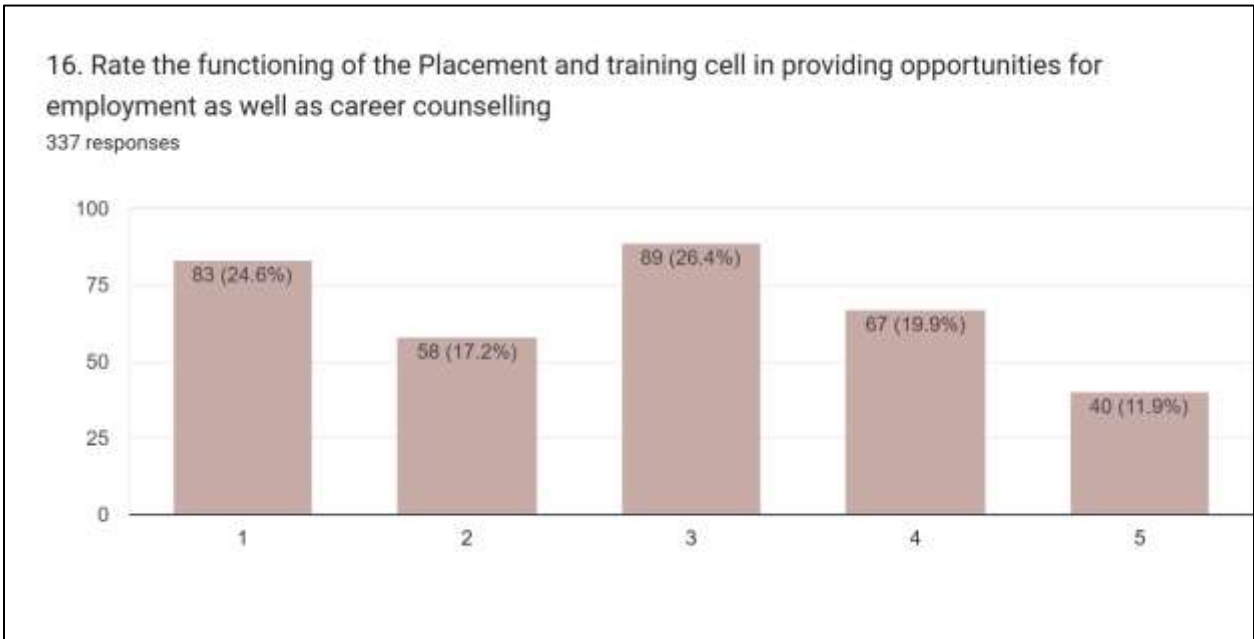
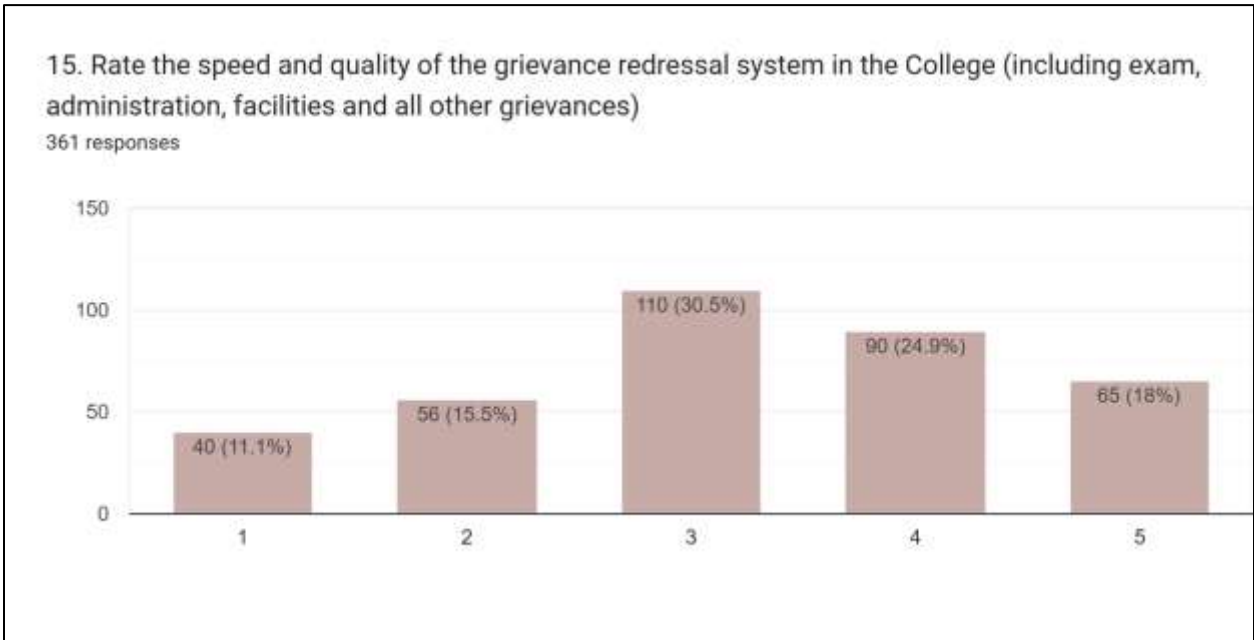


14. Rate the overall landscaping and green environment in the campus

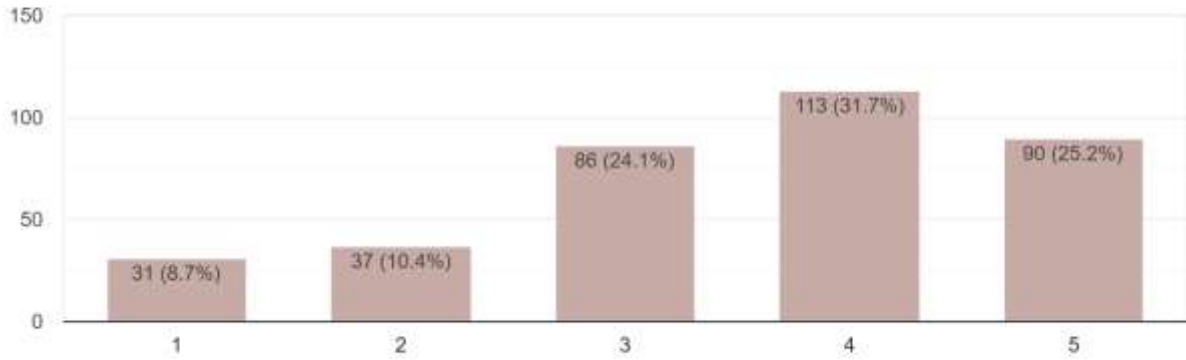

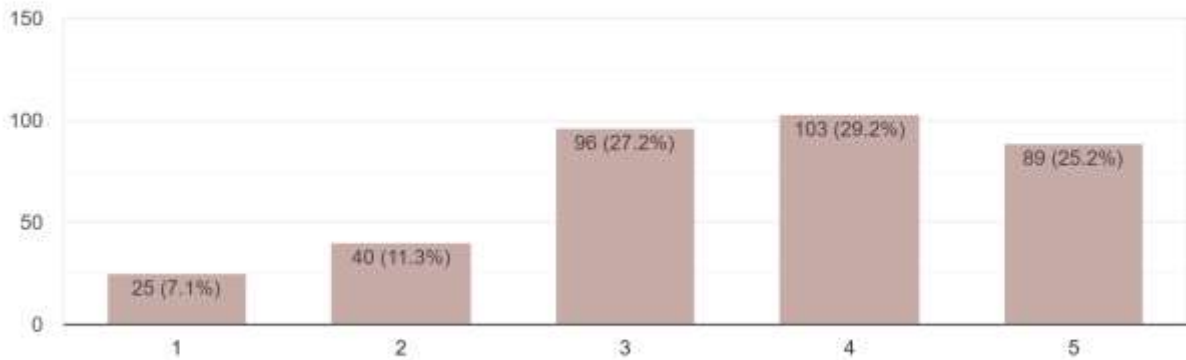
17. Rate the activities of the Extra-curricular committee in providing opportunities to showcase your talent

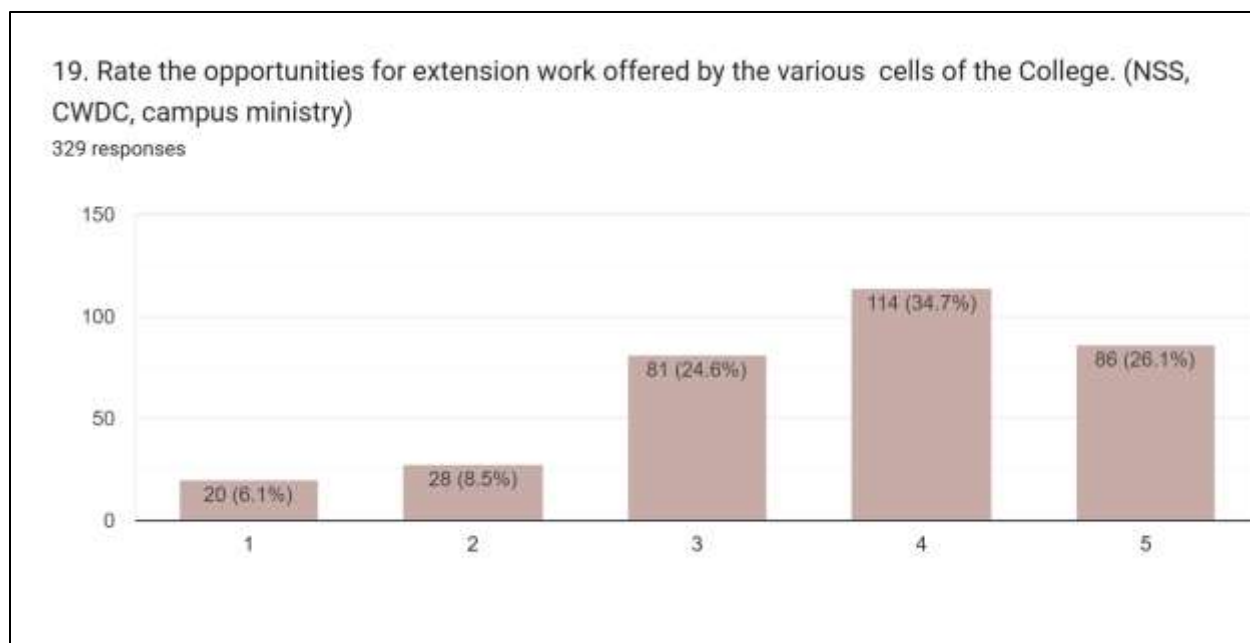

SURVEY ANALYSIS

From the survey conducted, it is concluded that:

- 38% of the students rated the alignment of the NEP with their academic and personal development goals from good to excellent
- 43.9% rated the introduction of technology in education as good to excellent
- Most of the students seem to have an average satisfaction with the online courses and 39% students find the assessment methods under NEP to be good to excellent
- 43.8% feel the NEP provides adequate opportunities for skill development
- 63 % of the students rated the quality of teaching as good to excellent and 43.2% students felt that there was good to excellent usage of ICT tools by teachers
- 55.9 % students responded that the syllabus was relevant and 45 % students felt that there was good amount of content in the syllabus offering skill-development, entrepreneurship, and employability
- 43% students rated the offered remedial classes, seminar and other co-curricular activities as good to excellent
- 50% of the students are satisfied with the internal and external evaluation pattern
- The rating of the classroom ambience, library, sports facilities, canteen and the landscaping are good while the hostel still remains a matter of concern
- 50-60% students are satisfied with the activities of the ECC, Research and NSS

- The students are generally dissatisfied with the functioning of the placement and training cell

The survey identified the following plans for the next academic year:

- Strengthening of the placement cell
- Curriculum structuring under NEP
- Improving the ICT facilities in the College
