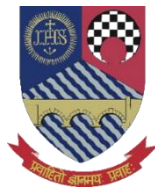

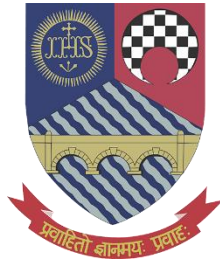

The academic year 2025–2026 has presented both challenges and opportunities as the institution prepares, for the first time, to introduce a fourth year in its undergraduate programmes, aligning them with the initial year of postgraduate studies. These developments are enhancing the teaching and learning environment, equipping our students for future professional endeavours and advanced study. The continued existence of the institution is attributed to the commitment demonstrated by its educators and learners.

### **1.0 People who left for heavenly abode**

The families of our staff members are considered an integral part of our institution, and we express our deepest condolences for their recent losses. We respectfully remember Dr. Pranav Shrivastav, former Head of the Chemistry Department at Gujarat University and board member (husband of Dr. Mallika Sanyal); Smt. Lataben A. Shah, mother-in-law of Dr. Bijal Shah; Mr. Kulandai Samy, father of Fr. Dr. David Roy K.; and Mr. Samuel Macwan, father of Fr. Dr. Sunil Samuel Macwan. Their passing has left a significant void in our community. Additionally, we mourn the loss of several retired staff members, including Dr. Arun P. Patel, Prof. S. B. Nayak, Mr. Nahemyah Christian, and Prof. Shiraz Laliwala. Their contributions are fondly remembered, and they remain in our thoughts and prayers.

### **2.0: Administrative Changes**

During this academic year, the institution experienced notable administrative advancements that contributed to a renewed atmosphere and enhanced vitality. Fr. Dr. Vinayak Jadav Retired due to superannuation and Fr Dr. David K Roy took over as Principal of the college in June. Mr. Ramesh Kalal and Mr. Edwin Macwan retired after serving the institution for several years. Mr. Agnelo Gonsalves retired as Office Superintendent after 33 years of dedicated and valued service to the institution. Following his retirement, Ms. Anita Patel assumed charge as the Office Superintendent, bringing with her a new enthusiasm for the role. Mr. Johnson Christian took charge as the Accountant, and Mr. Virendra Makwana stepped into the responsibility of Head Clerk, Ms, Cini Denny assumed the charge of Administrator of SF office and Ms. Renita D'Souza joined as clerk and Mr. Prakash Garasiya joined as a peon to strengthening the administrative team.

At the academic level, the institution was also delighted to see new leadership emerge: Dr. Fr. David K. Roy has been appointed as the Director of the College under a revised administrative structure and Dr. Sebastian Vadakan as Principal. Fr. Johnson Kuruvilla SJ will serve as the General Administrator, with Mr. Tony as the Assistant General Administrator. Additionally, Dr. Sudeshna Menon has been appointed as Deputy Controller of Examinations (CoE), Dr. Uma Harikrishnan as Deputy IQAC Coordinator, and Dr. Shital Doshi as Deputy NEP Coordinator. Dr. Pravida Raja assumed charge as Head of the Department of Data Science, Dr. Mitali Konnur took on the role of Coordinator of the BBA programme, and Dr. Mallika Sanyal was bestowed additional charge of heading the Department of Zoology.

The year was further marked by a refreshing wave of growth, with 32 new staff members joining the institution, even as 15 colleagues retired or moved on after their valuable service. These transitions signify a period of sustained progress, revitalization, and optimistic prospects for the institution.

### **3.0. Academics**

#### **3.1. Doctoral degree**

The following scholars enrolled in the Ph.D. programme during the year: Ms. Viji Vadakan, Ms. Ashwini Kshatriya, Ms. Deepa Fernando, and Ms. Payal Gupta.

Several faculty members were awarded doctoral degrees or have submitted their PhD thesis during the year. Dr. Mayurkumar Shinde was awarded his Ph.D. for his work titled “૧૯મી સદીની કેટલીક ગુજરાતી રોજનીશીઓનું સાંસ્કૃતિક અધ્યયન.” Dr. Erica Macwan was awarded her Ph.D. for the study “An Empirical Study on Strategic Management of Dark Emotions among the Students of Higher Education in the State of Gujarat.” Dr. Sonal Thakur defended her PhD viva on “Isolation, screening and characterization of polyethylene degrading bacteria from soil for enhancing their degradation potential”. Ms. Srishti Chhabaria submitted her PhD thesis, on “Study and characterization of different plant extracts for their efficacy as Dipeptidyl peptidase-4 inhibitors to manage diabetes”.

PhD students of several faculty members too were awarded PhD degrees. Dr. Himalay Kolavada, Dr. Jignesh Barot were guided by Dr. Sanjeev Gupta of the physics-electronic department, while Dr. Prerak Patel by Dr. U. M. Prajapati. In addition, Ms. Ushma Joshi submitted her Ph.D. synopsis under the guidance of Dr. Mohammed Faisal Ansari. These accomplishments exemplify the faculty’s robust research culture and dedication to academic excellence.

#### **3.2. Competitive examinations/ Recognitions**

It is immensely gratifying to see 58 of our students clear various competitive examinations like NET, GSET, CAT, NMAT, XAT, SNAP, GATE, JAM. (**Annexure\_1**).

Dr. Sanjeev Gupta was awarded the Best Teacher award by GSA and Dr. Rajavi Oza was awarded the Yuva Pratibha Sanman. Dr. Kinjal Bhatt was awarded Women scientist of Gujarat State by Microbiology Society of India, Mr. Shaunak Vyas won Global Gujarati Award 2026 and Dr. Vikram Panchal for Best Director. Ms. Disha Khetani, Dr. Angel Mary Joseph, Ms. Parnasi Khare, Ms. Srishti Chhabria, and Ms. Urmi Panchal won awards for best poster or oral presentations. Students from several

departments have participated in seminars and competitions and won accolades.

### 3.3. Innovative Learning methods

The institution employs a student-focused, experiential teaching–learning approach that prioritizes *learning by doing*, fostering conceptual understanding, analytical competence, and industry preparedness. Instruction extends beyond traditional lectures to incorporate case studies, projects, internships, research tasks, and real-world problem-solving activities. The integration of such experiential learning, technology, research orientation, peer collaboration, and fieldwork encourages active student engagement, enhancing analytical skills, innovation, and interdisciplinary insight.



Students analyze corporate reports, engage with authentic datasets, and undertake internship-based projects, particularly prominent in programs such as MSc AI and MSc BDA, Physics and Electronics. A variety of innovative and interactive pedagogical methods are integrated into the curriculum. For example, Sanskrit instruction utilizes communicative strategies, debates, role-plays, and digital tools like infographics and digital epigraphy. Sociology and Theatre students produce films addressing social themes, while Statistics courses adopt puzzles, simulations, and software applications including R, Advanced Excel, and Jamovi. Practical sessions leverage technology through live demonstrations, specialized software, and online assessments via Moodle and Google Forms.

Collaborative learning is actively promoted through peer teaching, group discussions, mock interviews, presentations, and laboratory teamwork. Departments also implement discipline-specific innovations: Chemistry leverages simulations and peer demonstrations; Botany includes field studies, mini research projects, and microgreens cultivation; Mathematics organizes field visits; Biochemistry and Biotechnology facilitate educational excursions, concept mapping, exhibitions, and science contests to provide practical experience. The Department of Computer Science organized Internal Hackathon 2025 with 24 students from BCA, Data Science, and IT focusing on AI-driven applications and interactive sessions on debugging

The Department of Sanskrit offered events such as debates, shloka recitations, skits, dance performances, and presentations on research methodology. A special lecture, “Jyotish Shastra: Enlightenment through Vedic Astrology,” was held, and students visited Gyan Mandir and Jain Museum in Koba to study ancient manuscripts and cultural heritage. Gita Jayanti was commemorated with elocution contests, dance, shloka recitations, a book exhibition, and a quiz. An educational visit to Somnath–Veraval provided exposure to religious heritage, tribal communities, and local industries. Quizzes were administered via Moodle LMS to support digital and continuous assessment.

The Department of Sociology advanced experiential learning through theatrical productions based on sociological theories and concepts, facilitating creative interpretation. The department emphasized project-based learning, internships, and industry exposure; students participated in remote internships with organizations such

as IBM and local companies under faculty guidance. Enrichment was furthered through SWAYAM MOOCs, blended learning using Moodle LMS, and courses encompassing “Fundamental Concepts of Sociolinguistics” and “Media, Information and Empowerment.” Educational tours to Nandigram were coordinated by Gujarati and Sociology departments.



The Department of Commerce promoted internships, research involvement, and academic competitions. Thirty-two students each from MSc AI and MSc BDA are pursuing Semester IV internships across various organizations, while MSc BDA Semester II students are enrolled in the SWAYAM course “Statistical Foundation for Big Data Analysis,” assessed through MCQ tests. Students receive guidance in both funded and unfunded research endeavors, research paper composition, and seminar attendance. The Commerce Club fosters learning through regular concept-driven posts on Instagram; MCQ tests are conducted via LMS as part of CIA-2. Additional activities include a three-day Hands-on Instrumental Analysis Workshop an industrial visit to Wave Analytical Lab LLP, and an interdisciplinary expert talk on Nanotechnology by Dr. Ramesh V. Upadhyay in partnership with the Physics Department.

The Department of Botany implemented research-oriented, field-based, and ICT-supported learning strategies. Students undertook mini research projects, dissertations, herbarium-centered taxonomic studies, and case analyses related to climate change and biodiversity. Field trips to forests, botanical gardens, medicinal plant gardens, exhibitions, and Ayurvedic pharmaceutical industries enabled biodiversity documentation and ecological data acquisition. Skill-building activities included certificate courses (such as Herbal Cosmetology) and botanical illustration workshops. Virtual labs, digital herbarium tools, online resources, and electronic submission of assignments were utilized. Project tasks encompassed soil analysis, ecological surveys, carbon sequestration studies, and IKS-aligned projects supporting Sustainable Development Goals. Industry interaction and internships were arranged with entities including the Forest Department, Serenity Botanical Garden, Ultratech Industries, nurseries, and Arvind Mills. Enrollment in SWAYAM courses was encouraged.

### **3.4. Academic competitions**

Eco fest (cognizance) is a great student centric learning mechanism for the department of Economics where students learn economics through games. Department also organized several talks which are of relevance to current times and career growth of students.

The Department of English organized the second edition of Litanza, a literal festival with competitions as innovative way to impart education.

Department of Gujarati-Hindi organized ‘Matrubhasha Mahotsav’ and a live poetry



recital programme to give students a flair of Gujarati literature.

Department of Psychology offered a myriad of experience to students through International seminar on Resilience to revolution: Hope, healing and harmony. The Psychology department also organized various competitions, workshops, focusing on mental wellbeing and improving the

happiness quotient and field visit to Hospital. Manotsav is a psychology-based competition that explores the fascinating world of the human mind and behavior. It provides a platform for students to express psychological concepts creatively and engagingly. Many students participate in various competitions as part of Manotsav.

Department of Theatre & Production Management participated in several competitions to win accolades by both staff and students. Students also are exposed to short film making. These opportunities give good exposure to students to the world of Theatre.

The Department of Biochemistry and Biotechnology has integrated a variety of skill-based modules into its curriculum, empowering students to engage in small-scale research initiatives, training to clear NET examination, workshops, exhibitions, collaborative learning opportunities, video-assisted instruction, and concept mapping exercises. Approximately 128 students participated in internships or research projects aimed at furthering their academic expertise. Additionally, the department organized an International conference (Present Day Biology 2025) that served as a forum for students to present or review research and facilitated valuable interactions with invited speakers. BioCalyx is one of the flagship events of the Department of Biochemistry and Biotechnology.



It is a lively festival where science and creativity come together. Students from across Gujarat participate in this state-level event, making it a platform to learn, share ideas, and explore the world of biosciences in a fun and engaging way.



Department of Chemistry exposes students to Wave Analytical Lab for an exposure. Training to crack competitive examinations, bridge programmes, poster presentations

to bring awareness on safety in lab are student centric approached taken by the department. The signature programme of Chemistry “Chem Cho” was organized with wider participation and innovative competitions.

The department of Physics-Electronics continue to organize the Advanced Physics programme. Staff and students participated in hands on workshop on Multi-Messenger Astronomy, various seminars talks and competitions. The department also organized the Dr. Tushar Pandya Memorial Lecture. Another student centric approach is the participation of large percentage of students in research projects as part of curriculum.



Department of Microbiology organized a National conference on Microbial Maestros for Sustainable Development, and celebrated World Microorganism Day, through “Micromarvels”.

The Department of Statistics organized a field visit to Anand Agricultural University, while Microbiology and Biochemistry-Biotechnology scheduled visits to industrial facilities, providing students with valuable practical experience. The Department of microbiology visited Genexplore to familiarize students with modern scientific gadgets, Mathematics arranged a field visit to Science City, Physics electronics to PRL campus, and the Department of English facilitated a visit to Mirzapur Cathedral, launching a club focused on mental well-being. Department of Zoology encouraged students to participate in Science Manthan and other science competitions and seminars.

Sci-Blast, an engaging science event that sparks curiosity and innovation among students, was organized on campus by the Research Committee. It provided a platform to explore scientific ideas through experiments, models, and presentations, encouraging creativity and critical thinking. A large number of school students participated, making learning interactive, and enjoyable. In-house research projects worth ₹9.8 lakhs were sanctioned to staff and students to promote research activities on campus.

Department of Computer science and Biochemistry - Biotechnology systematically conducted mentoring to support and motivate students to excel in both academic and non- academic fields.

Commerce, psychology, chemistry, Physics, zoology, Mathematics have working MoUs.

The Department of Sanskrit celebrated Sanskrit Day and organized educational trips for students. The Department of Sociology actively engaged students through visits to institutions such as the Blind People’s Association and Gujarat Vidyapith, and also fostered awareness by celebrating Constitution Day. The Department of Botany enhanced students’ skills by conducting workshops on horticulture and hydroponic farming, with students also participating in and winning several competitions. The Department of Statistics organized a Statistics Conclave along with celebrations for

National Statistics Day. The Department of Data Science conducted workshops on “Computer Vision and Machine Learning” as well as “Spatial Data Analytics.” The Department of Computer Science organized an internal hackathon and seminars focused on career counseling and ethical hacking. Meanwhile, the Department of Mathematics conducted various problem-solving workshops and provided Olympiad training for students.

### 3.5. Staff Academic Achievements

Several staff and students published their research work. Dr. Ishwar Mahera published a book. Dr. Vijaysinh Dhandhukiya, Dr. Dhara Bhatt, Dr. Manali Brahmabhatt, Ms. Viji Vadakan, and Ms. Srishti Chabbaria published research papers (**Annexure\_2**)

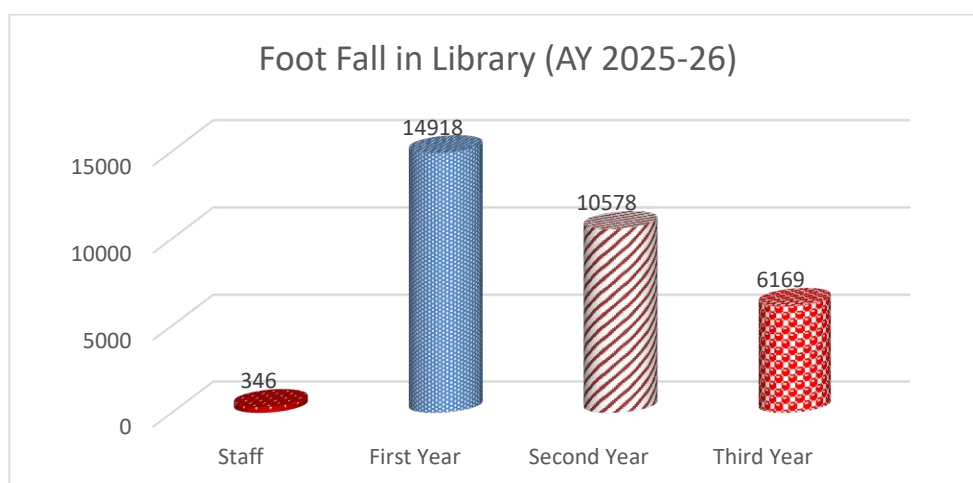
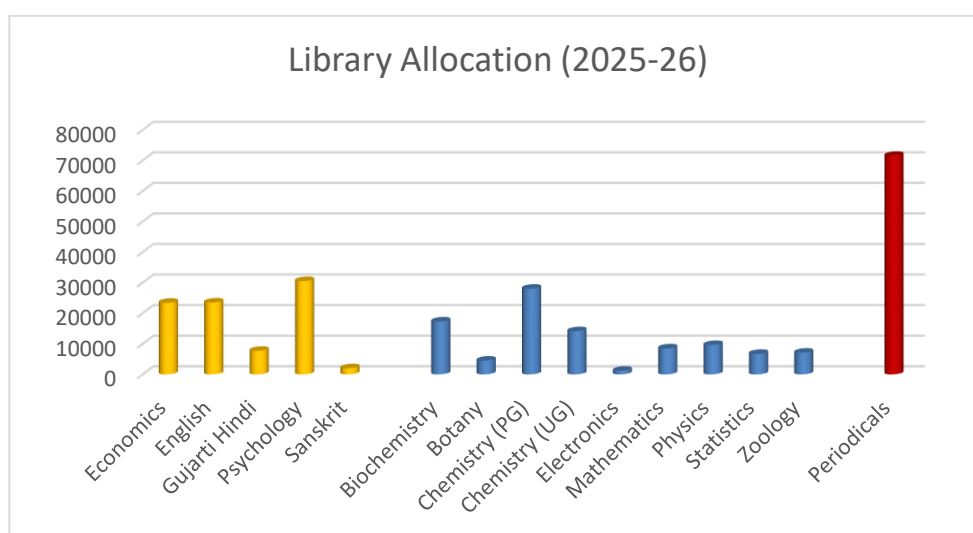
A total of sixty nine students who completed in-house research were felicitated at the Research Medal Ceremony. Nineteen staff members were also recognized for their research contributions. The Department of Biochemistry & Biotechnology was awarded Best Department for Research, with Physics-Electronics as the runner-up. Dr. Shivani Shah received the Researcher of the Year award, while Dr. Sanjeev Gupta was honored as Star Researcher. The Management offered two lakhs each to department of Computer and Data Science, Psychology, commerce and Biochemistry-Biotechnology to conduct conference.

The Chemistry department has undertaken several initiatives to enhance the

professional development of both teaching and non-teaching staff. Faculty members are encouraged to develop e-content, video lectures, and interactive statistical simulations to strengthen digital pedagogy and innovative teaching practices. Subject experts are invited to engage in discussions and provide insights into solving higher-order thinking problems, thereby enriching academic discourse. The department also ensures mentoring support for newly appointed teachers to help them adapt to institutional practices and improve their teaching effectiveness. Further, the establishment of the ChemStore Online Application has strengthened administrative efficiency and resource management, supporting the professional functioning of both teaching and non-teaching staff.

### 3.6. Library

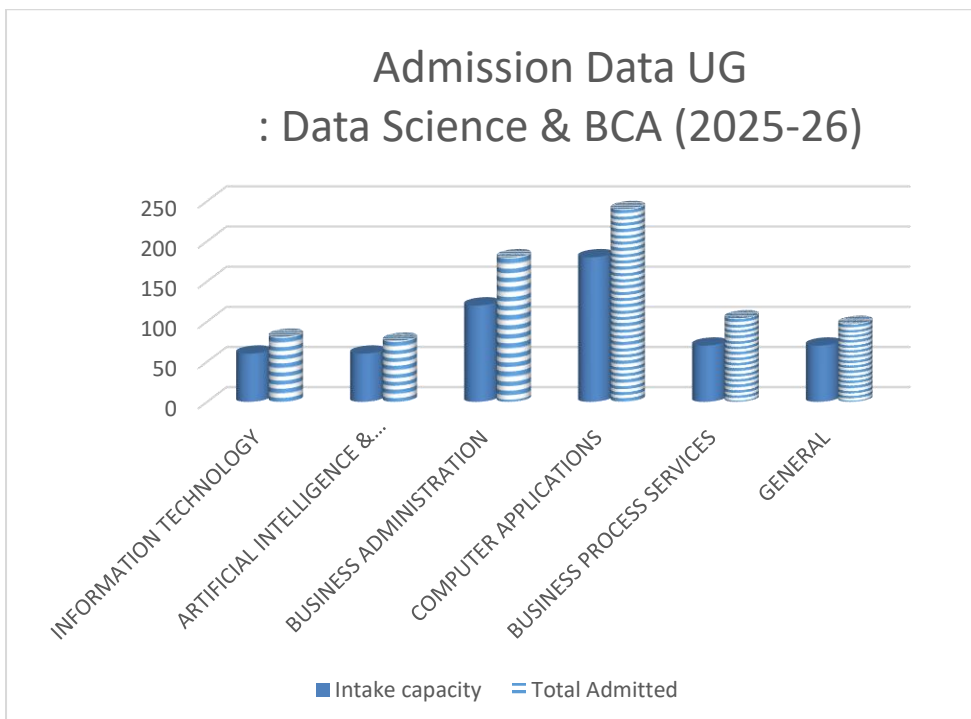
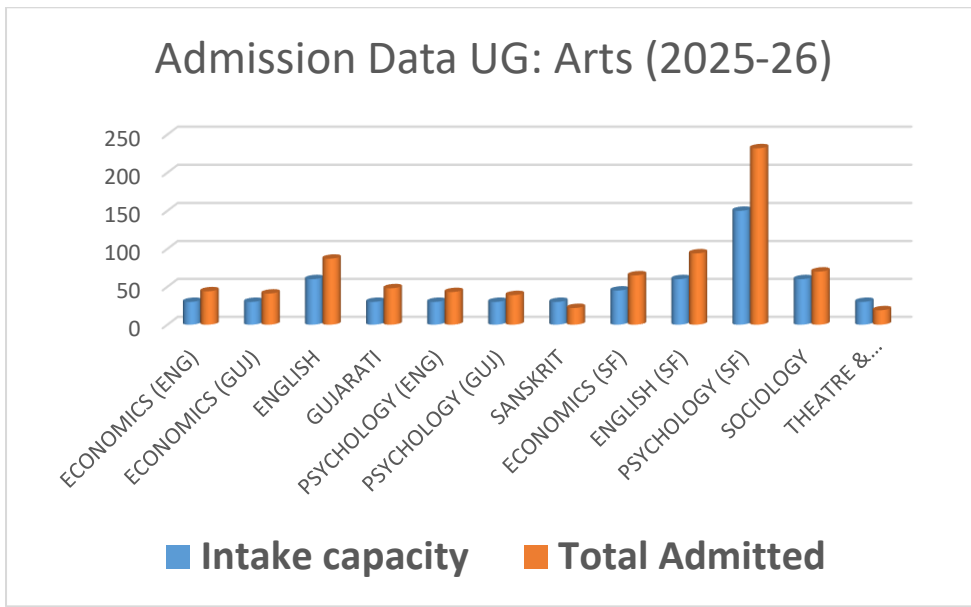
The library allocated ₹71,493 for the acquisition of 17 periodicals. During the current academic year, books valued at ₹1,84,100 have been added to the collection. Additionally, the library section organized a seminar entitled “Library Books are my Valentine,” which saw robust participation from students.



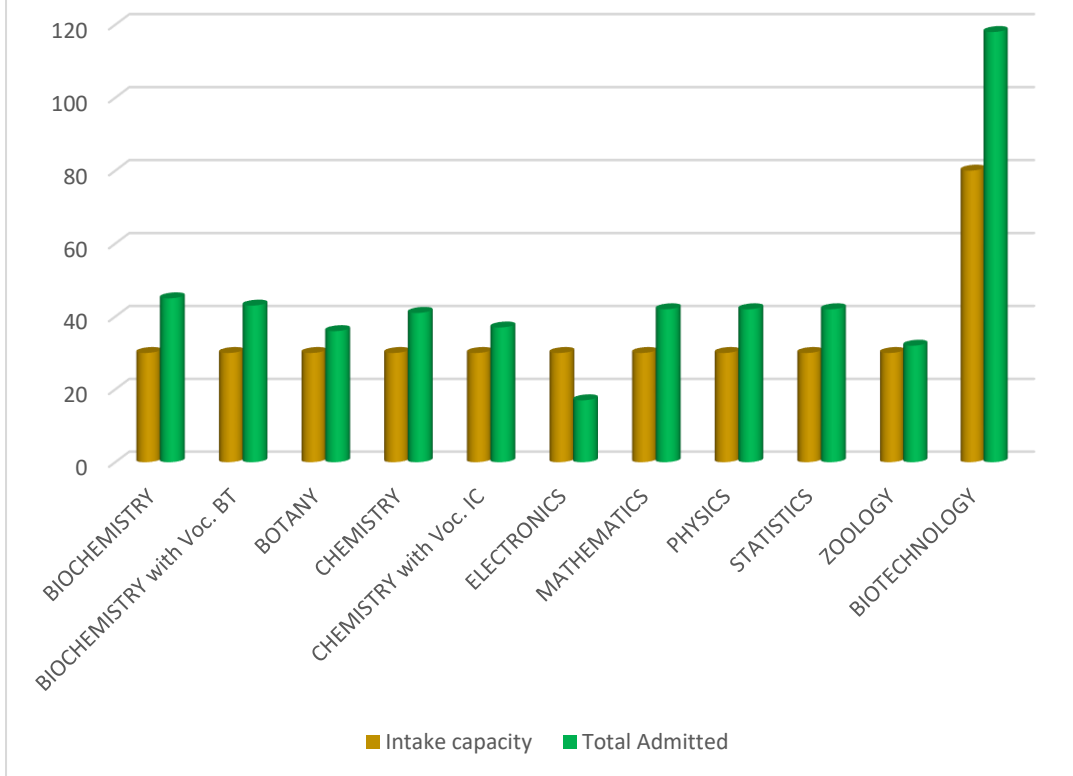
### 3.7. Admissions

The college in this Academic session began admissions in May 2025, as an independent autonomous institution. Admissions, however, were shifted mid-cycle to

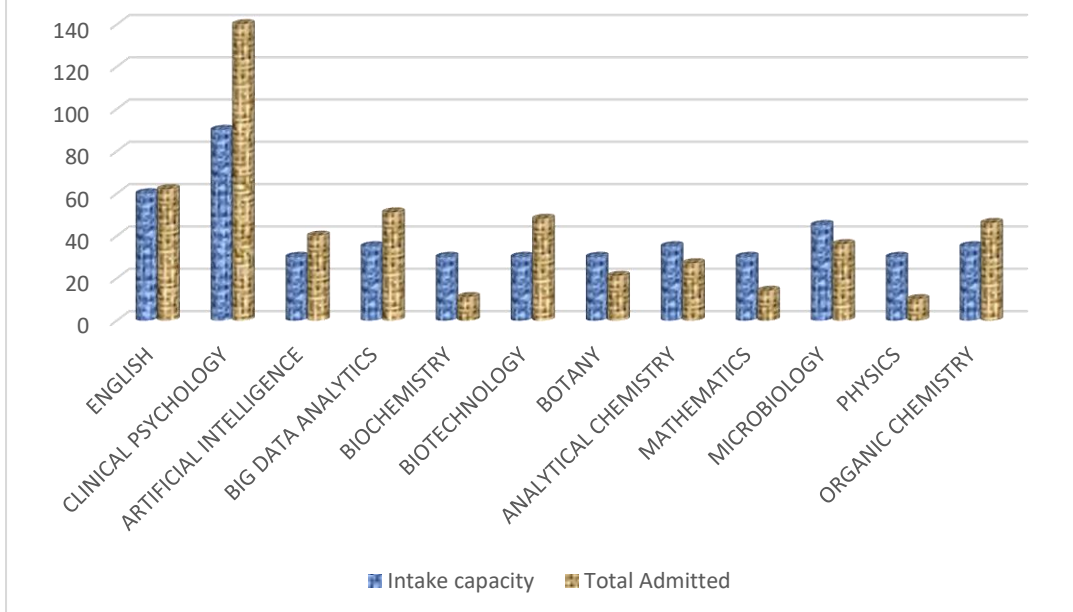
the Gujarat Common Admission System, requiring large-scale data migration, verification, and continuous coordination. Admissions were conducted for 41 programmes, comprising 17 UG (GIA), 1 PG (GIA), 12 UG (Self-Financed), and 11 PG (Self-Financed) programmes. Three new undergraduate programmes, BBA, B.Sc. Information Technology, and B.Sc. Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning were introduced during the academic year, while the B.Sc. Computer Science programme was discontinued. A total of 2,583 students were successfully admitted across undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.

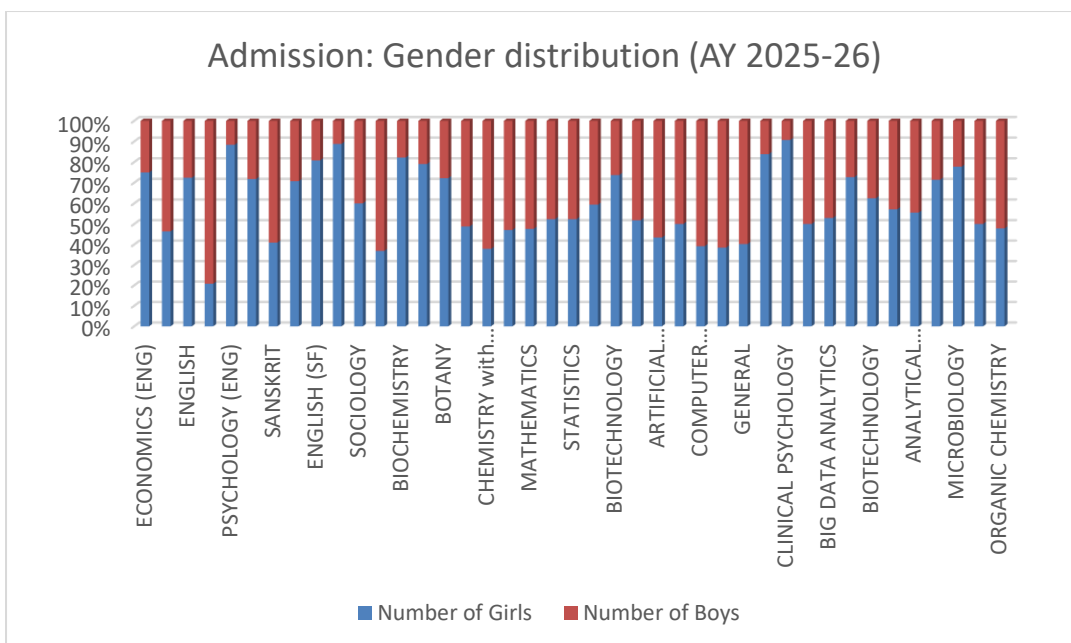


### Admission Data UG: Science(2025-26)

### 3.8. NEP

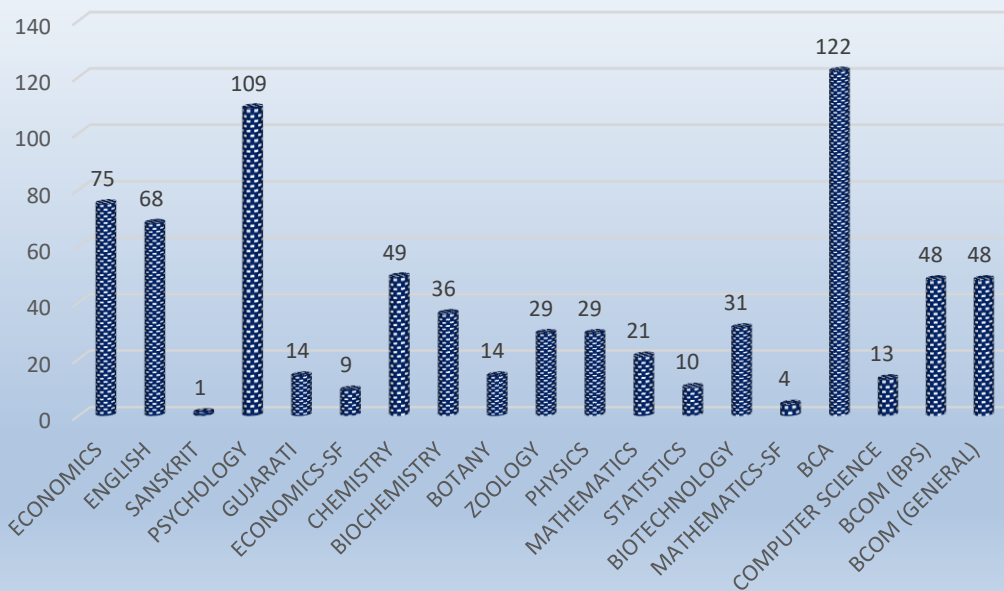

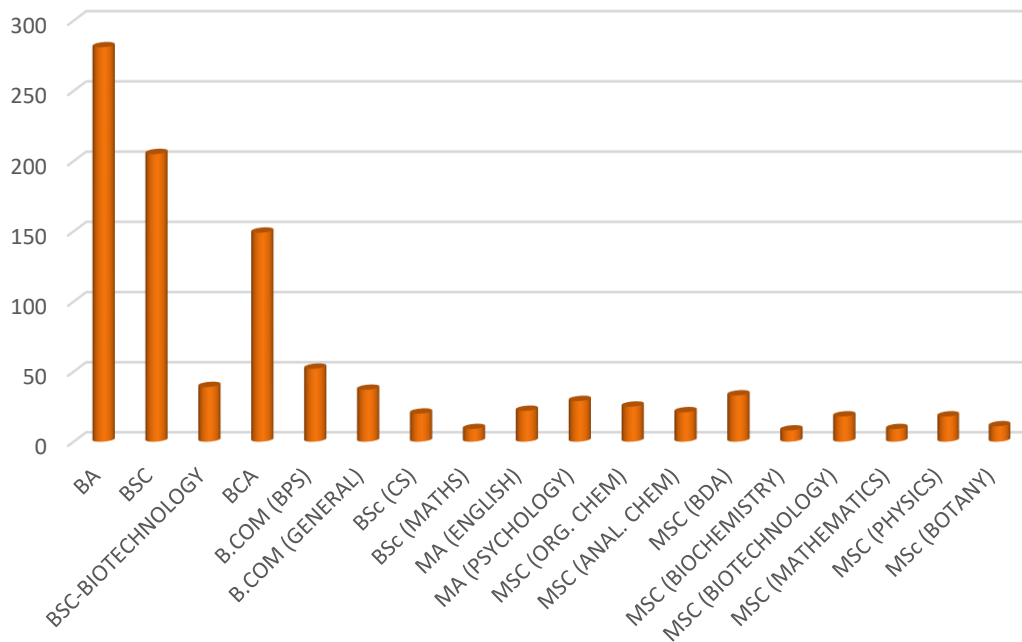
### 3.9. Result

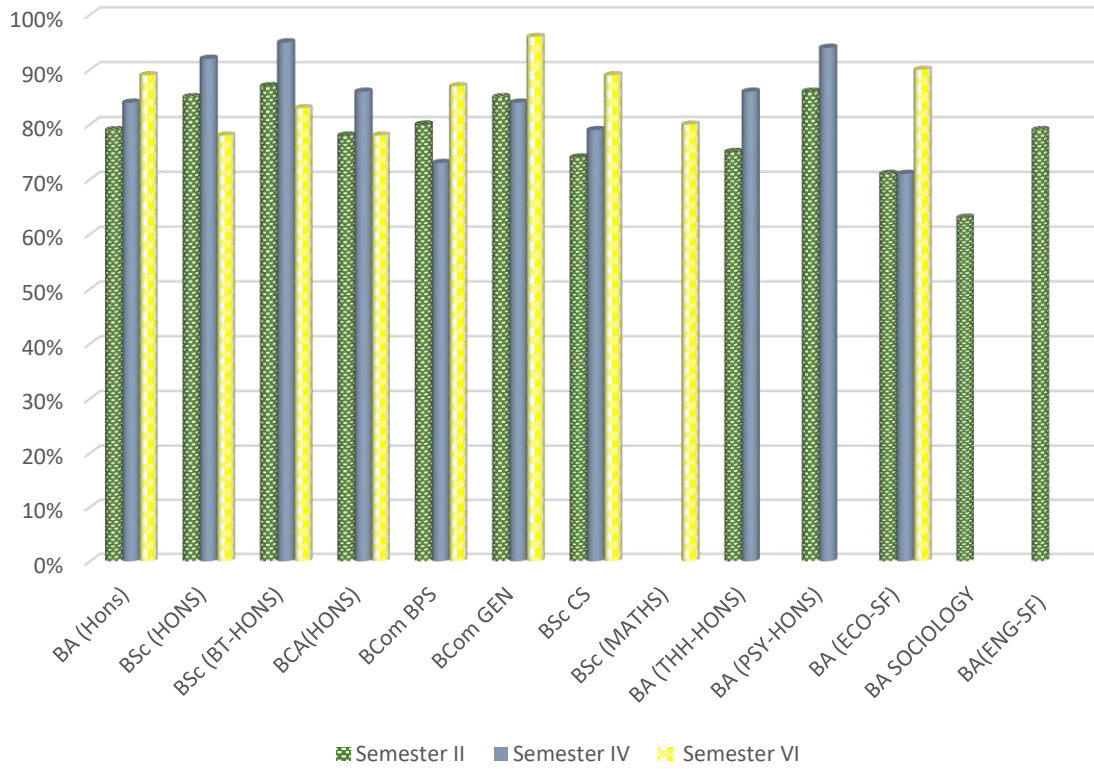
Graduated students UG (December 2025)



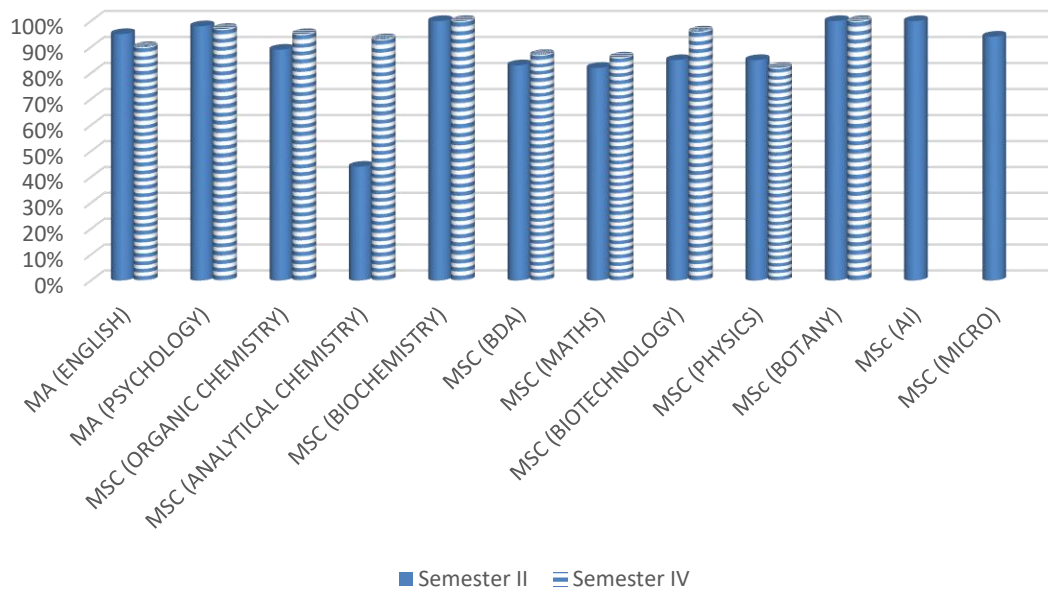
Number of students graduated in 2025



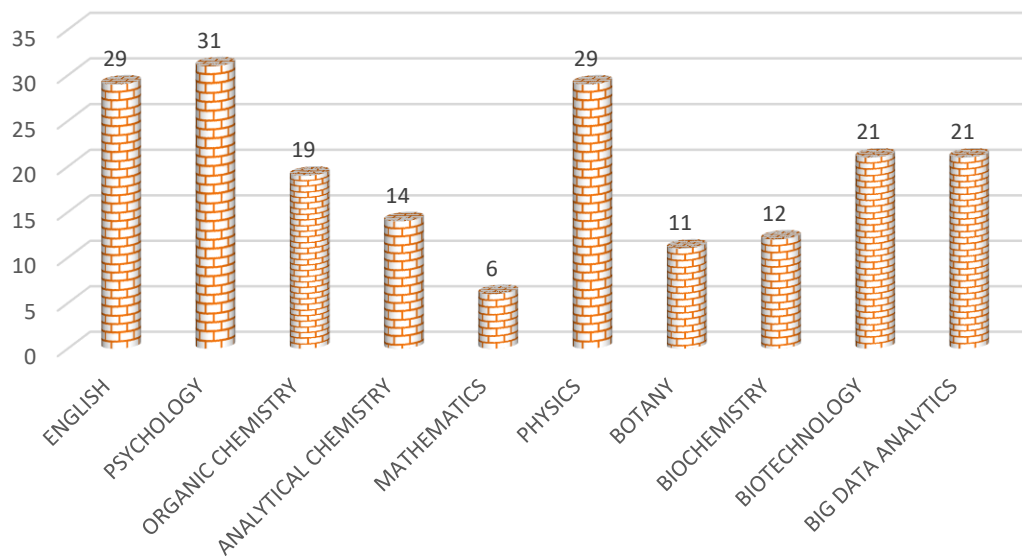
### Result Even Semesters (UG) April 2025



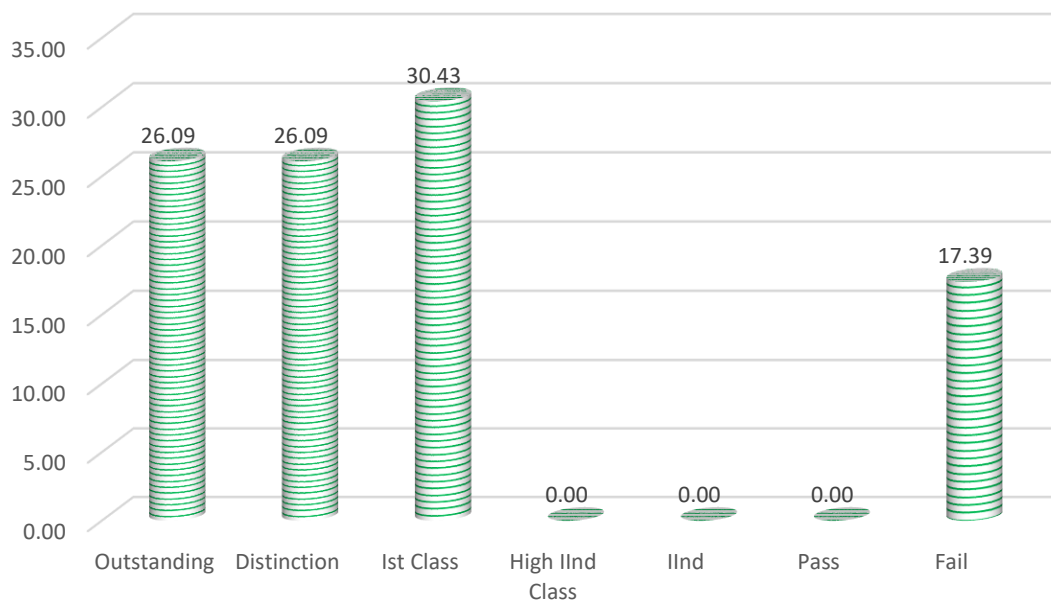
### Result Even Semesters (PG) April 2025



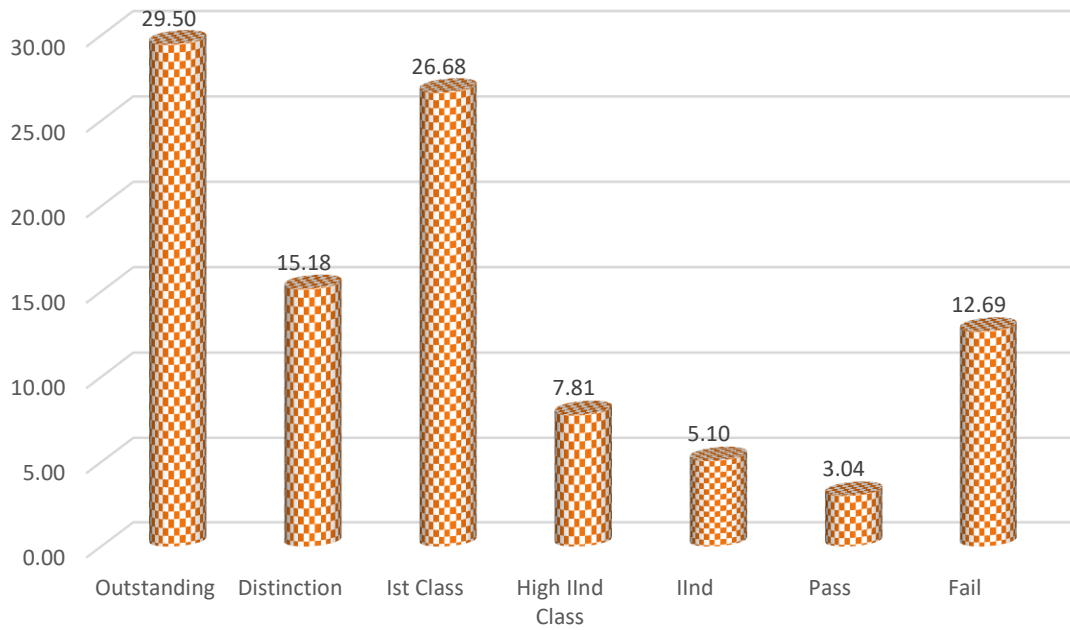
### Graduated students (PG) (December 2025)



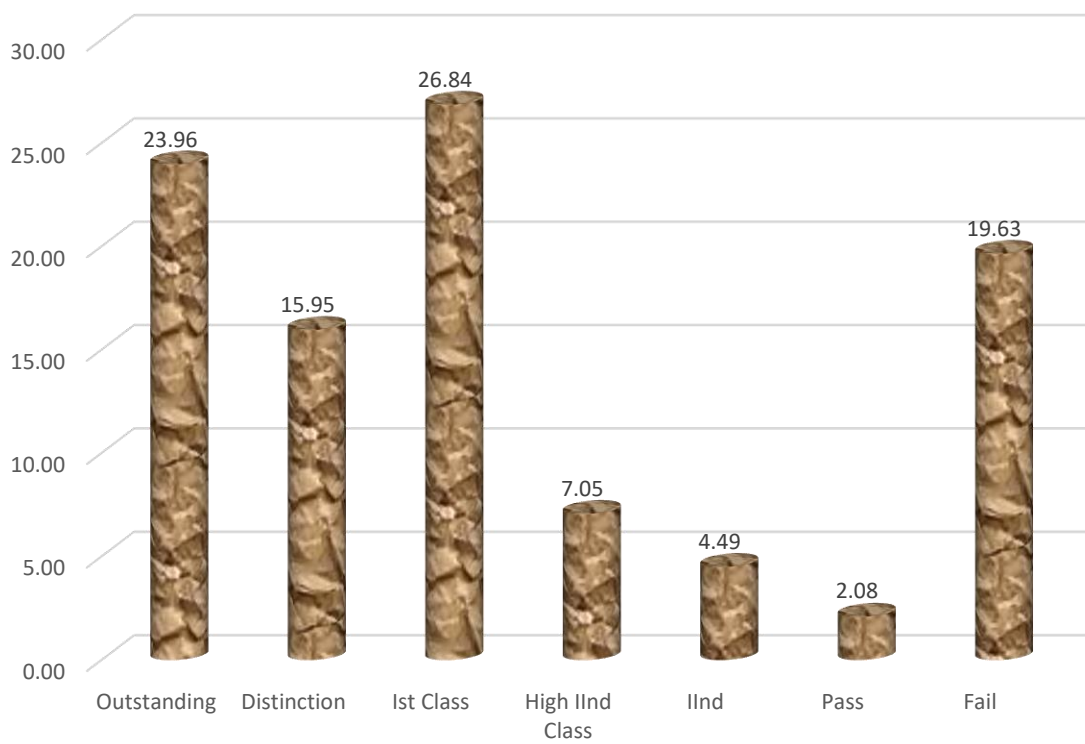
### Result Sem VII (UG in %) January 2026

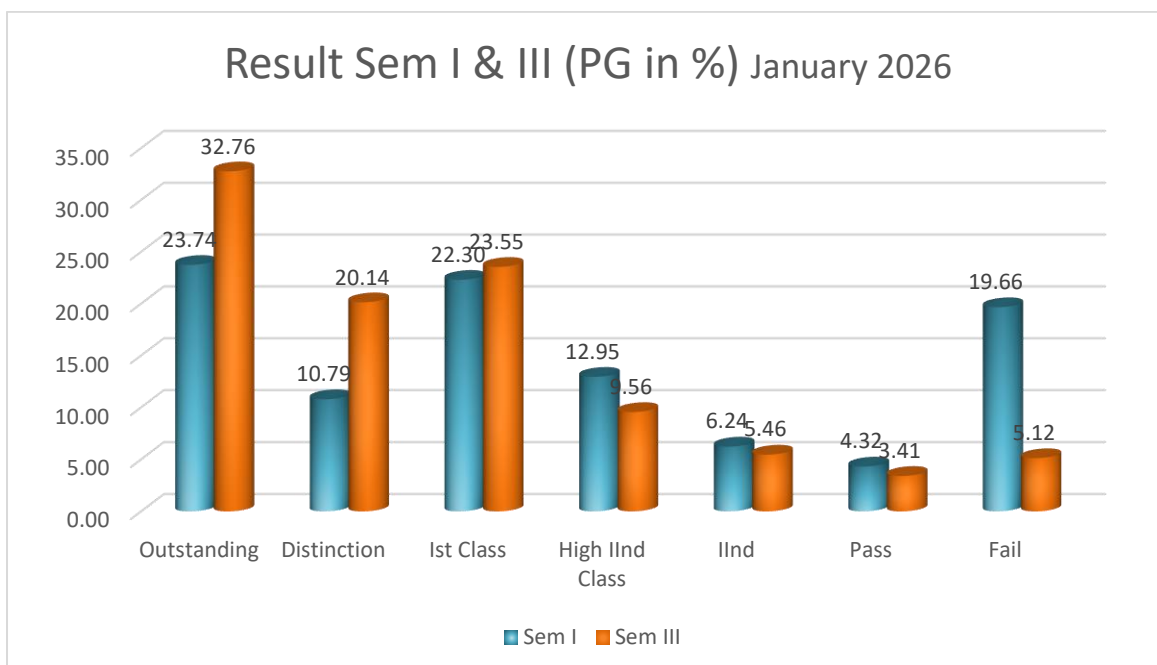
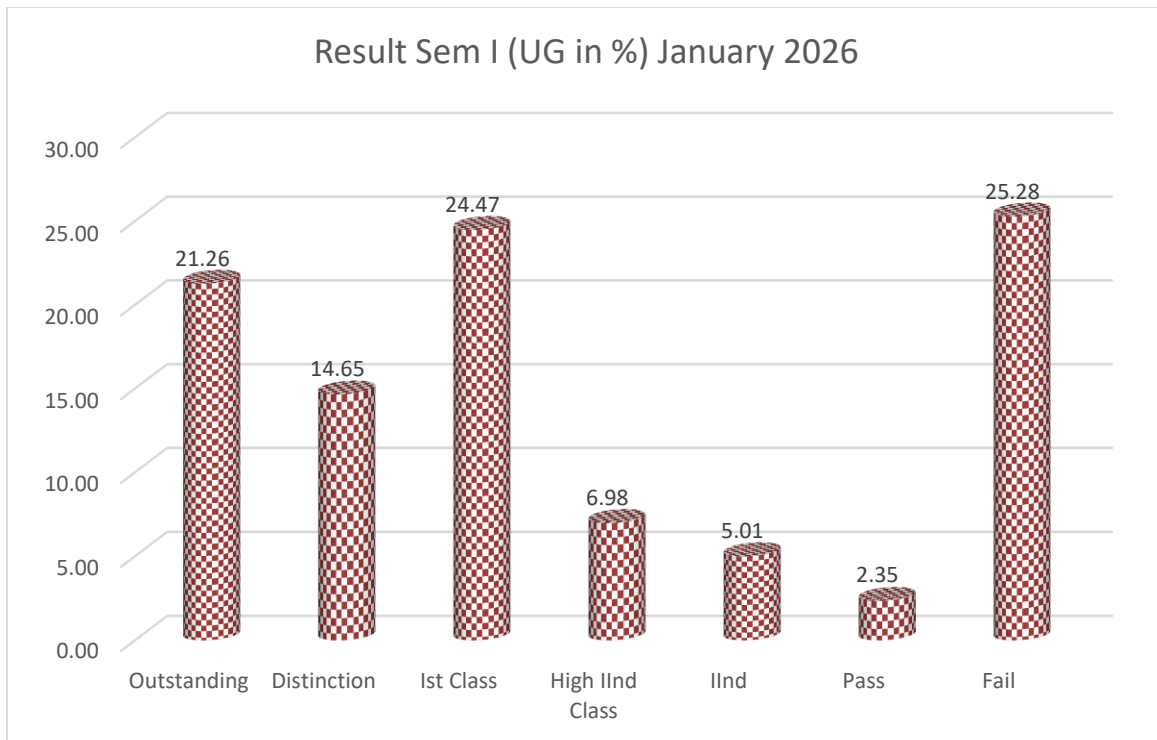


Result Sem V (UG in %) January 2026

#### 4.0. Faculty Development Initiatives

##### 4.1. IQAC contributions

The IQAC and HR Department collaboratively implemented initiatives to reinforce NAAC's seven criteria and advance quality enhancement efforts. The Xavier's Induction Programme provided orientation for 112 new staff members, followed by the Staff Fun Fusion: Spark of Joy session, facilitated by Mr. Joseph Noronha, which contributed to fostering team spirit and morale. For non-teaching staff, the programme "Together We Grow: Reasonably, Responsibly & Respectfully," conducted by Mr. Michael P. Christian, enhanced communication and collaboration within the team.

Faculty development initiatives included “Building an Emotionally Supportive Campus” by Dr. Khushnuma Banaji and “Elevate with AI” by Mr. Harshit Shah and Mr. Aditya Singhal, both of which were designed to promote well-being awareness and encourage innovative teaching methodologies.



During the year, IQAC aligned its initiatives with institutional goals by submitting data to AISHE, participating in NIRF, India Today and The Week surveys, conducting a Green Audit, and an Internal Academic Audit. The autonomous status extension report was submitted. Key surveys included Student Satisfaction/Graduate Exit, Faculty Feedback, and UG Honours Exit Survey for the NEP Office. IQAC also prepared an

Institutional Development Plan, held regular review meetings with NIRF-based recommendations, and issued recruitment guidelines to HR. Additionally, Dr. Mallika Sanyal and Ms. Remi Clement participated in national workshops and AISHE training, further strengthening institutional quality practices.

#### **4.2. Innovation club**

The Innovation Club of St. Xavier’s College, Ahmedabad achieved notable recognition during the year. Ms. Jenisha Jayswal was selected for the KCG live dialogue “Idea to Impact: Innovation Unplugged,” while Mr. Aadarsh Raj, Ms. Sumanya, and Mr. Ashishkumar won 1st Prize at the Budding Innovators Meetup–2026 organized under SSIP Navadhara and SPSEC.

The Club conducted several capacity-building programmes, including a startup lifecycle workshop by Mr. Yash Padiyar, a Design Thinking workshop by Mr. Karamjitsinh Bihola of Innodesk with 48 participants, and a two-session “Lab-to-Market” workshop by Mr. Mithilesh Patel benefiting 175 students. A five-day “Code to Concept” workshop by Mr. Chintan Patel from IIM Ahmedabad and team trained 32 students in Python, AI, and business applications. The innovation club under the leadership of Dr. Pranav Trivedi and Mr. Nisarg Vyas have been granted 40 Lakhs funding from GoG under SSIP.

#### **5.0. Extracurricular activities**

##### **5.1. ECC**

The Extra-Curricular Committee (ECC) promotes the holistic development of students by encouraging participation in creative, cultural, and leadership activities alongside academics. During the year, the committee organized orientation programmes for newly enrolled students and coordinated participation in the Gujarat University Youth Festival. With active mentoring and coordination by ECC, the college secured victories in 15 events and first place in the rally at the South Zone Festival, and prizes in 12 events at the inter-zonal level. The institute also represented the West Zone in One Act Play and Western Solo Singing, winning third prize in the One Act



Play and qualifying to represent the zone at the national level in Chennai and won third prize. (**Annexure\_7**).



The Cultural Festival CulFest-25 – *Antarnaad: A Symphony of Creativity* was conducted with notable enthusiasm. The event was attended by Ms. Swati Pandit, Vice President–HR at IMS Group, as Chief Guest, and Mr. Makrand Shukla, distinguished actor, as Guest of Honour. The festival included inter-departmental competitions spanning Arts, Commerce, BCA, and Science, engaging approximately 700 students. The Psychology Department received the Winner's

Trophy, while the English Department was awarded the Runner-up Trophy. The successful execution of the festival can be attributed to the dedicated efforts of the volunteers and the Extra-Curricular Committee faculty led by Dr. Disha Khetani and her team.

## 5.2. Equal opportunity Cell

St. Xavier's College organized a session titled "Equal Opportunities for All" to promote awareness, inclusivity, and motivation among SC–ST students. The Equal Opportunity Cell conducted two programmes for the benefit of students with the support of Mr. Anil Purabiya, former FRRO officer and on Career Exploration by Mr. Immanuel Gamit.



## 5.3. Career cell

The Career Cell organized a series of career-focused programs aimed at preparing students for the professional world. The Career Cell also conducted programmes such as Emerging Trends in Management, a two-day workshop on Computer Vision and Machine Learning, G-20 Empower Tech Equity, a Digital Awareness Session on Upskilling, a Pre-Placement Talk for Teach for India, and a two-day Career Launchpad workshop on Resume and Interview Skills were organized to enhance students' career readiness. During the year, 51 students were placed through campus recruitment by companies including Godrej Enterprises, South Indian Bank, KPMG, NIQ, Baxter Pharmaceuticals, O2h Discovery, Intas Pharmaceuticals, ICICI Prudential, Tatvic Digital, TCS, L&T EduTech, and others. The coordinator Dr. Urvi Chhaya and Mr. Nelson Macwan are working towards inviting more recruiters to the campus, and also conducting workshops or seminars encouraging progress towards higher studies in India and overseas.

## 5.4. NSS

The NSS wing of the college has conducted several activities as well as participated in several events through the year. Yoga Day, Cleanliness drive, Thalassemia testing camp, Stem cell awareness camps, Blood donation campaigns, Fact checking workshop, Road safety awareness are some of the activity highlights of NSS in the current academic year. In collaboration with NDRF, NSS conducted a workshop on



Disaster Management. Ms. Zeel Thakkar, an NSS volunteer was selected to be part of the parade in the NSS contingency at the 77<sup>th</sup> Republic Day parade, (**Annexure\_8**)

### **5.5. Collegiate Women Development Cell (CWDC)**

The Collegiate Women Development Cell conducted street plays to raise awareness about women's safety and legal rights, as well as programmes focused on mental well-being and stress management.

Additionally, the cell organized a seminar on cervical cancer awareness and a walkathon. International Women's Day was celebrated with creative games. (**Annexure\_9**).

### **5.6. Campus Ministry**

Under the inspiring leadership of Sr. Jisha and Fr Darrel Veloz SJ, the Campus Ministry remains a beacon of compassion, positively impacting the lives of both students and staff. The ministry has organized a variety of meaningful activities, including inaugural prayer sessions, staff birthday celebrations, condolence prayer meetings, and the observance of various feast days, alongside providing counselling services.

The Ministry also extends its care to visually and physically challenged students, as well as fourth-class employees, ensuring inclusivity and support for all. Their outreach efforts include celebration of Gujarat Utkarsh Day, regular visits to old age homes, orphanages, and the Blind People's Association, as well as offering short training programs for children from nearby communities. The cell also takes care of the PGOP for the whole college. The selfless dedication of the Campus Ministry in nurturing the well-being and spirit of the entire campus community is highly appreciated (**Annexure\_10**).

### **5.7. Community and Social Development Activities**

Several faculty members actively contribute to community and social development beyond academics. Dr. Ishwar Mehra is associated with the Global Bhavi Foundation, Khambhat. Dr. Erica Macwan, Dr. Profaina Christian and Mr. Stephen Christie engages with a religious organization. Mr. Vijay Sinh Dhandhukiya is linked with an international human rights NGO and with Jeev Daya for animal and bird care. Dr. Atman Shah serves as NSS Programme Officer, Dr. Arti Oza is involved with Ambika Dham, supporting academic and counselling efforts. Dr. Atul Makwana serves as Joint Secretary of ACTI-Ahmedabad, reflecting strong commitment to community engagement and social responsibility.

Several students contribute actively to community and social development. Ms. Sreeja Matravadia works with The Listening Circle promoting mental health awareness through street plays. Mr. Gokhale Rohan is associated with SAHAAY NGO. Mr. Prashant, through Campus Ministry, teaches underprivileged students in Jamalpur

and organizes educational visits. Ms. Avanika Kakaria, through NCC, engages in environmental and community initiatives including Kankaria Lake cleaning, tree plantation, ground cleaning, and First Aid training. Overall, these efforts reflect strong student engagement in social responsibility, education, mental health awareness, and environmental sustainability.

### 5.8. NCC



The NCC offers a comprehensive program designed to promote the holistic development of cadets. It provides structured opportunities for growth in discipline and leadership, supporting cadets in achieving their full potential. Under the supervision of Dr. Vijaysinh Dhandukiya, Dr. Kirtan Parmar, and Ms. Hemangi Jatia, cadets have demonstrated the ability to balance academic responsibilities with notable achievements in NCC activities. Participation in various skill-building initiatives, such as national integration camps and combined annual training, has enhanced cadets' physical and mental abilities while fostering camaraderie, accountability, and national pride.

### 5.9. Sports

St. Xavier's College participated in 25 games organized by the Ahmedabad Zone Local Sports Committee of Gujarat University. A total of 204 students took part in intercollegiate tournaments, and 48 students (23 boys and 25 girls) represented the college at All India Inter-University and national-level competitions.

In the men's section, the college competed in events such as swimming, chess, table tennis, badminton, cross country, football, basketball, volleyball, cricket, kho-kho, hockey, kabaddi, tennis, and athletics. The teams secured first place in football, basketball, chess, hockey, and athletics, second place in tennis doubles, and third place in cross country. The football team also emerged Champions in the Ahmedabad University Inter-College Football Tournament.



In the women's division, students engaged in table tennis, badminton, volleyball, basketball, tennis, chess, football, wrestling, swimming, cricket, kho-kho, and athletics. The teams achieved championship titles in swimming, volleyball, basketball, tennis, and table tennis, secured second place in badminton, football, and cricket, and placed third in chess. Notably, the girls' football and cricket teams participated for the first time, each earning second place in their respective competitions.

Among individual achievements, Patel Siddhi and Diya Sen won the Inter-College Table Tennis Championship, with Patel Siddhi also being selected for the Inter-University tournament and winning a Gold Medal in Khel Mahakumbh. Ms. Krisha Shah excelled in swimming, winning gold medals in 50m and 100m Freestyle and 50m, 100m, and 200m Breaststroke, becoming Inter-College Champion and qualifying for the Inter-University tournament, along with three silver medals in the Senior State Championship. In Inter-College Chess, Mr. Varun Jhangiani and Mr. Pranav Liladhar won the men's championship, while Ms. Riya Mourya and Ms. Arab Arusha secured third place in the women's category.



Notably, Ms. Krisha Dalal and Ms. Savi Panchal won the Gujarat University Inter-College Tennis Championship, secured third place at the West Zone Inter-University Tournament, and qualified for All India University. The college also continued its strong legacy by winning the Inter-College Basketball title for the 10th consecutive year and the Football title for the 16th consecutive year. Furthermore, St. Xavier's College retained the Overall General Championship in Sports and Athletics at Gujarat University for the 15th consecutive year.

#### **5.10. Benefactors, Alumni and well-wishers**
