MoM for the IQAC and MICRO IQAC Meeting

Date: 11th December 2024

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The IQAC and MICRO IQAC Meeting of St. Xavier's College, Ahmedabad was held on 11th December 2024 to review and discuss the progress of ongoing quality assurance initiatives across various agenda points, as detailed below.

Agenda 1: External meeting of IQAC

It was informed that the external meeting of the IQAC was conducted on 5th October 2024 in the presence of the external members. The following highlights of the meeting were shared with the committee:

- The on-the-spot admission procedure adopted by the college was appreciated by the external members.
- The Binary Accreditation framework was explained to the members present.
- Concern was expressed regarding placement.
- It was recommended that a Gender Audit be conducted along with the Green Audit.
- Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) on life skills-interpersonal relations and on the Binary Accreditation framework were suggested.

Agenda 2: Student Progression Link

It was informed that the Student Progression link had been prepared by the IQAC:

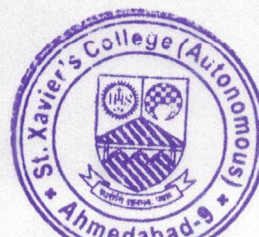
The link was sent to the COE Office and was floated among the students. It was reported that 607 responses had been received so far, and it was decided that reminders would be sent to increase the response rate further.

Agenda 3: Faculty Feedback

It was informed that the Faculty Feedback link had been floated among the students through the respective departments and that responses were being received. It was decided that the links would be blocked by the following day and that the responses would be analysed by 24th December 2024. It was also noted that a challenge had been faced in the process, which the committee took note of

Agenda 4: Student Satisfaction Survey

It was informed that the Student Satisfaction Survey had been floated among all the students of the college through the respective departments, using the following link:

It was informed that the survey included feedback specific to NEP 2020, covering the following aspects:

- The extent to which NEP 2020 aligns with students' academic and personal development goals.
- The impact of the introduction of technology in education, such as online learning platforms and digital tools, on the learning experience.
- Satisfaction with online courses, including the conduct of classes, study material provided, and attendance recorded.
- Whether the new assessment methods under NEP 2020, focusing on continuous assessment and holistic development, are perceived as fair and effective.
- Whether NEP 2020 provides adequate opportunities for skill development, such as vocational training and internships, alongside academic learning.
- The challenges or difficulties faced by students with the changes introduced under NEP 2020.
- Suggestions from students for improving the implementation of NEP 2020 at the institution.

Agenda 5: GSIRF Ranking

The GSIRF (Gujarat State Institutional Ranking Framework) 2024 results were presented and discussed by the committee. It was noted that among the top five ranked colleges, four were from Charutar Vidya Mandal University and the fifth was from Parul University, with all five belonging to private universities.

The ranking parameters and their respective weightage were reviewed, comprising Teaching, Learning & Resources (40%), Graduation Outcomes (25%), Research and Professional Practice (15%), Outreach and Inclusivity (10%), and Perception (10%).

A comparative overview of student strength, out-of-state and out-of-country enrolment, and EBC/SC-ST-OBC representation across peer colleges (P. D. Patel, Ipcowala, Istar, SEMCOM, Parul, and SXCA) was presented. Comparative data on library expenditure, laboratory equipment, capital assets, salaries, number of full-time teachers, and research papers across these institutions was also reviewed.

It was noted that St. Xavier's College secured an overall GSIRF score of 65.01 in the ranking exercise.
